
Tips from your neighborhood nurse

igh Blood Pressure/Hypertension (Silent Killer)
More than 360,000 American deaths in 2015 included high blood pressure as a primary or contributing cause. That is almost 1,000 deaths each day.

High blood pressure increases your risk for dangerous health conditions:

- First heart attack: About 7 of every 10 people having their first heart attack have high blood pressure.
- First stroke: About 8 of every 10 people having their first stroke have high blood pressure.2
- Chronic (long lasting) heart failure: About 7 of every 10 people with chronic heart failure have high blood pressure.
- Kidney disease is also a major risk factor for high blood pressure. (CDC.gov)

DYSFUNCTION

- Frequently check your BP and definitely keep a BP journal if on medications. You can check at your local Publix, Walmart, Walgreens or CVS
- Understand the risk factors- this includes those that are uncontrollable such as age, ethnicity, and familial history
- Limit salt and sodium and eat potassium rich foods: Use more herbs than table salt; read food labels when shopping; Most people only need 1500mg/day of sodium; eating foods high in potassium can also aid in reducing blood pressure
- Limit alcohol consumption- two drinks/day for men, one drink/day for women
