



Biggest dinosaur ever dug up in South America

ove over, T. Rex, brontosaurus, and other giant dinosaurs—you've just been replaced. Scientists have discovered the largest dinosaur to ever walk the earth. It's been named Dreadnoughtus by paleontologists at Drexel University, who unearthed its skeleton at a dig in Argentina.

The creature was as tall as a two-story building, over 80 feet long, and weighed more than 130,000 pounds, making it the biggest land animal known to date. It lived during the Cretaceous period, 66 million to 84 million years ago. Its name, from Old English, appropriately means "fear nothing."





JAN	Carnation	This Eurasian plant has a spice scent. It is also called the Clove Pink or Gillyflower and range in colors from pink to purple-red. They are said to symbolize love, fascination and distinction.						
FEB	Violet/Iris	They come in various shades of blue, mauve, yellow and cream. They symbolize faithfulness, humility and chastity.						
MAR	Daffodil	This yellow flower is also known as Jonquil or Narcissus. It symbolizes regard and chivalry and is indicative of rebirth and new beginnings.						
APR	Sweet Pea or Daisy	Sweet Peas come in a variety of colors. It is symbolic of departure after having a good time. It indicates pleasure and bliss. The Daisy symbolizes innocence, purity or cheerfulness.

White: Innocence Cream: Appreciation Green: Vitality Yellow: Friendship Orange: Enthusiasm Salmon: Desire Red: Romance Peach: Gratitude Pink: Sweetness Lavender: Charm
JUL	Larkspur or Delphinium	The Larkspur means an open heart and ardent attachment. Pink symbolizes fickleness, white means joy and purple a sweet disposition. The Delphinium means big-heartedness, fun, lightness and levity.
AUG	Gladiolus	"Love At First Sight" is the meaning of this flower. It also means character, faithfulness, honor and remembrance. continued on page 11

Christmas – Did You Know?

- Christmas is a contraction of "Christ's Mass," which is derived from the Old English Cristes mæsse (first recorded in 1038). The letter "X" in Greek is the first letter of Christ, and "Xmas" has been used as an abbreviation for Christmas since the mid-1500s.
- In AD 350, Pope Julius I, bishop of Rome, proclaimed December 25 the official celebration date for the birthday of Christ.
- In the US, it was in 1870 when Christmas was declared an official holiday.
- Alabama was the first state in the United States to officially recognize Christmas in 1836.
- Oklahoma was the last state to declare Christmas (in 1907).
- The traditional three colors of Christmas are green, red and gold. Green is a symbol of rebirth and life, red symbolizes the blood of Christ and gold represents light as well as wealth and loyalty.
- Santa Claus is based on a real person, St. Nikolas of Myra. He lived during the fourth century and was also known as Nikolaos the Wonderworker, Bishop Saint Nicholas of Smyrna, and Nikolaos of Bari). Born in Patara (in modern-day Turkey), he is the world's most popular non-Biblical saint. Artists have portrayed him more often than any other saint except Mary. He is the patron saint of banking, pawn broking, pirating, butchery, sailing, thievery, orphans, royalty and New York City.
- Early illustrations of St. Nicholas depict him as stern, commanding, and holding a birch rod. He was more a symbol of discipline and punishment than the jolly, overweight elf children know today.
- Rudolph's red nose is probably the result of a parasitic infection of his respiratory system.
- Santa's reindeer are females but they have male-sounding names.
- Would you believe that there are about 20,000 "Santas" across the US?
- Evergreens symbolize eternal life and rebirth and have been used since ancient times.
- Mistletoe is from the Anglo-Saxon word *misteltan* which means "little dung twig" because the plant spreads through bird droppings Yuck!! That takes the fun out of the kissing.



- The earliest known Christmas tree decorations were apples. At Christmastime, medieval actors would use apples to decorate paradise trees (usually fir trees) during "Paradise Plays," which were plays depicting Adam and Eve's creation and fall.
- The first artificial Christmas trees were made out of dyed goose feathers.
- Commissioned by Sir Henry Cole (1808-1883), British illustrator John Callcott Horsley (1817-1903) invented the first Christmas card in 1843.
- More than 3 billion Christmas cards are sent in the US alone.
- Many couples break up in the two weeks just before Christmas.
- Believe it or not, suicide rates during the Christmas holiday are low. The highest rates are during the spring.
- If you send all the gifts of the Twelve Days of Christmas, it would be a total of 364 gifts.
- Did you know that the "true love" mentioned in the song "Twelve Days of Christmas" refers to God? The "partridge" represents Christ and the "turtle doves" represent the Old and New Testaments.
- Wassail is from the Old Norse ves heill, meaning "good health."
- It is estimated that the single "White Christmas" by Irving Berlin is the best-selling single of all time, with over 100 million sales worldwide.
- The first Christmas postage stamp was issued in the United States in 1962.
- Christmas purchases account for 1/6 of all retail sales in the U.S.



Save a life: Recognize the symptoms of stroke

very minute matters when someone suffers a stroke. Prompt medical attention can make a huge difference in whether the person lives or dies, as well as in the quality of his or her recovery. Be alert for these warnings signs so you can take fast action:

- Difficulty walking. The person may appear dizzy, off-balance, or uncoordinated on his or her feet.
- Speech problems. Stroke can affect a person's ability to remember words or pronounce them correctly, making him or her seem confused or intoxicated.
- Drooping face. One side of the person's face may droop or look frozen.
- Difficulty with arm movements. Ask the person to lift both arms. An inability to raise his or her hands may indicate a stroke.
- Headache. Stroke can cause a sudden, severe headache accompanied by nausea or vomiting. If you observe, or experience, any of these symptoms, seek medical help right away.

Walking vs. running: Which is for you?

alking and running are two of the simplest exercises a person can do. Neither requires special equipment aside from a good pair of shoes, and you can do either one almost anywhere. Which one is better for you? Let's compare:

• Running. A good run burns more calories, making it a good choice for weight loss. Runners also tend to be in better shape overall than non-runners. However, running puts stress on your legs, feet, hips, and joints, so runners should be careful to avoid injury.

• Walking. A vigorous walk can have the same health benefits of running, although you'll have to keep it up longer. On the other hand, you can walk almost anywhere, and won't run the risks mentioned above. Just make sure to put some effort into it; a casual saunter won't get you into shape no matter how far you go.
