

WIND POWER - CLEAN & RENEWABLE ENERGY

nergy solutions for the future will increasingly depend on the use of renewable energy resources. Wind power turbines provide a clean and renewable energy source and they are used around the world.

But, just what is wind anyway? Wind is the movement of air from an area of high pressure to an area of low pressure. Wind exists because the sun unevenly heats the surface of the Earth. As hot air rises, cooler air moves in to take its place. As long as the sun shines, wind will blow.

And, as long as the wind blows, people will harness it to power their lives.

People have been using wind power since ancient times. Ancient mariners used sails to capture the wind and explore the world. Farmers once used windmills to grind their grains and pump water. Today, more and more people are using wind turbines to produce electricity. Wind turbine use has increased greater than 25% a year in the last decade. But it still only provides a small fraction of the world's energy.

Most wind energy comes from turbines that can be a tall as a 20-story building and have three 200-foot-long blades. They look like giant airplane propellers on sticks. The wind spins the blades and they turn a shaft connected to a generator that produces electricity. The biggest turbines generate enough electricity to supply about 600 US homes. Large wind farms have dozens and even hundreds of these turbines lined up in windy spots, like along a ridge. But, a small wind turbine can be installed in a backyard to provide electricity for an individual home. Once installed, there is zero cost. These days, turbines are becoming much cheaper and sometimes tax incentives are offered.

There may be drawbacks, depending on your personal opinion. Some think the turbines are ugly and don't like the noise. They may kill birds but not as many as cars, power lines and high-rise buildings do. Of course, wind is variable, depending where you live. Still, the wind energy industry is booming! Usage has more than quadrupled between 2000 and 2006 (globally). Experts predict that if this pace of growth continues, by 2050, one third of the world's electricity will be provided by the wind. More jobs will be created as this industry grown.

Did You Know?

- The US currently has 61,110 MW of installed wind project capacity. This comprises 5.7% of the total US installed electric generating capacity.
- Windmills have been used since 2000 BC and they were first developed in China and Persia.
- Wind power is the fastest-growing source of electricity in the world. Iowa and South Dakota generated more than 25% of their energy from the wind in 2013.
- There is enough on-shore wind in America to power the country 10 times over. Think about that!
- Twelve states accounted for 80% of the US wind-generated electricity in 2013. They are TX, IA, CA, OK, IL, KS, MN, OR, CO WA, ND and WY.
- In 2013, California led the nation by installing new wind installations.
- Modern wind turbines produce 15 times more electricity than they did in 1990.
- A single wind turbine can power 500 homes.
- Most wind turbines (95%) are installed on private land.





Tortoises make their way back from extinction

Tow some good news from the world of nature: The Hood Island giant tortoise of the Galapagos Islands, whose once vast numbers had dwindled to only 15 in the 1960s, has surged back with help from scientists.

- Water. A tall glass of water revitalizes your body while assuaging hunger pangs. And it's caffeine- and calorie-free.


