### **Manager's Corner for January 2016**

- First and foremost, as 2015 comes to an end, I want to thank everyone in the Park who by their efforts and cooperation make Serendipity the great and beautiful community that it is. I also want to thank all the manager employees and all those who make my job here as Property Manager such an enjoyable one.
- Recently there have been reports of dogs being brought into the community by outside visitors. Rule # 20 of Serendipity's Rules and Regulations states in part the following: "No visitor's pets are allowed". As such, make sure to tell your outside company to leave their pets at home. If not, the violation falls back to you.
- The monthly rent amount will increase to \$460.00 effective February 1<sup>st</sup>. That is also the date that the new Rules and Regulations go into effect. If you don't have these Rules, please notify the office and they will be provided to you.
- The tie-down program was completed, and although there were a few issues, as a result, the program seems to have been a success, one that will help solidify the foundation of the homes that were a part of this program.
- There have been recent reports of some residents having difficulty moving their vehicles out of their driveways due to daytime parking issues. Please be aware and considerate of other when you or a guest of yours is parking on any of the streets during daytime hours.
- Just a quick note...please turn off the lights in the Clubhouses when you are the last one to leave.
- If anyone wants a phone book (not the in house directory, but those provided by Verizon) there are about 50 in the Park Office, so please stop in if you would like to have one.
- As for Serendipity's internal phone book, let us in the office know if there are to be any changes that you need to be made, or if you're not already in it, whether you want to be. Visit, call, or email the information to the Park Office no later than January 31st to guarantee the addition or change will be made. We would like to have these ordered as soon as possible in early February.
- HOPEFULLY, by the time you read this, the West Clubhouse renovation will be complete and all the apparent chaos and inconvenience that this caused will be over. And hopefully, all the residents will appreciate the continuous efforts being made by the ROC Board of Directors to keep upgrading your community. They are for the most part underappreciated and underpaid. (Just to make certain you know, there is no compensation of any kind for Board members)
- Thanks to all the staff at Serendipity, Marie, Eldene, Kevin, Bill and Paul for all your efforts and production this past year. In line with that, and if all goes well, I will update you as to all the accomplishments that the Park has made over the past year or so.
- In the meantime, have a fun filled and safe New Year and may the year 2016 be a great one for you.

### **Serendipity Family Recipes!**

### **CHOCOLATE MAYONNAISE CAKE**

Submitted by: Nanci Dorau from my mother, Margueritta Bildner's recipe file.

- 2 CUPS UNSIFTED FLOUR
- 2/3 UNSWEETENED COCOA
- 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> TSP. BAKING SODA
- 1/4 TSP. BAKING POWDER

- 3 EGGS
- 1 TSP. VANILLA
- 1 CUP HELLMAN'S MAYO
- 1 2/3 CUP SUGAR

Grease and flour bottoms for (2) 9" x 1 ½ round baking pans. In a medium bowl stir together flour, cocoa, baking soda and baking powder, then set aside. In a large bowl with a mixer at high speed, beat sugar, eggs and vanilla occasionally scraping the sides of the bowl. Mix for 3 minutes or until light and fluffy. Reduce speed to low and beat in mayonnaise. Add flour mixture in four parts alternating with the water (beginning and ending with the flour. Pour into prepared pans. Bake in the oven at 350 degrees for 30-35 minutes or until cake tester inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool in pans for 10 minutes. Remove, cool on wire racks. Frost as desired. Garnish with sliced almonds. Makes (2) 9" layers.

### **Shuffleboard**

BSERVATIONS:
These comments date back to nearly a year ago. I sat and watched the fun league play on a Tuesday and the following Thursday. A total of 48 people. The club seemed to be providing exactly what it claims to provide – FUN!!

If having fun is all you are looking for, do not change a thing; just keep on having fun. But if you want to become a better player (as well as continuing to have fun), some of these suggestions may be useful. And before I start, I must admit that sometimes an expert shuffler will do the very thing that I recommend that you should not do!

Lifting the cue off the board at the end of your shot is wasted effort and energy. Don't do it! Loosen your grip on the cue and let your thumb and first finger or two fingers provide a hinge-like hold on your cue. Now as you swing your arm, all the energy going into the shot will be more apt to stay in a straight line. By the way, you are holding the END of your cue stick aren't you? If you hold the stick one foot ahead of the end, you are, in effect, shooting from a further distance away than your opponent is. Also, your last step forward should be close to the foul line (but never on it).

There are a number of players who use the "push", "punch", or "poke" method of shooting. It's not a smooth delivery, and it is, therefore, more difficult to hit your target. Just as importantly, it is more difficult to achieve small changes in the distance that your disc will travel. The energy or speed, you put into your shot is often referred to as "how much weight" the shooter uses.

Instead of "punching" the disc, hold your arm straight and swing it forward. In this manner you will have better control of both direction and weight. The speed of your swing determines the weight (and therefore the distance the disc travels). By the time you finish following through on your shot, your hand should be high enough for your arm and cue to create a straight line.

When you learned how to throw a ball, swing a bat or just about any physical motion used in an athletic sense, you were told to "follow through"! Well, to follow through is just as important in shuffling as it is in anything else. When you think about using any one of the three "P" methods, it is at once obvious that there is no chance to follow through.

Are these all my ideas? Not at all. If you did not recognize these things as coming from "Attention All Novices", go the shuffleboard shed and borrow a copy from the bulletin board.

In any event: **KEEP HAVING FUN!** See you at the courts.

### Learn the ABCs of skin cancer

That dark spot on your skin may be a freckle—or it may be skin cancer. How can you tell? The American Academy of Dermatology takes an alphabetical approach to identi-L fying potentially dangerous skin conditions:

- A: Asymmetry. Is the spot or mole generally circular, or does one side look different from the other?
- **B:** Border. Is the edge of the item uneven, notched, or blurry?
- C: Color. Does the object vary in color in different areas?
- **D: Diameter.** Is the area larger than a pencil eraser?
- **E: Evolving.** Has the object changed its size, shape, or color?

Contact a dermatologist if you answer "yes" to any of these questions.

### Just a rash? Check it out

rash may be nothing to worry about, but sometimes it can be a sign of something serious. Doctors recommend you pay attention if a rash exhibits any of these symptoms:

- The rash spreads quickly across your body, which could indicate a major allergic reaction


