MANAGER'S CORNER FOR JULY, 2016

- The Park Office consistently receives compliments about the appearance of the Park and as such, I just want to thank everyone who continues to make Serendipity the wonderful community that it is. The most important contributors to the look of the Park are YOU the residents by making certain your home and outside area are kept clean and clear of clutter. You are the reason this is such a great place to live.
- Another major plus about Serendipity is the help that residents give to others in the Park, whether it being watching their homes when someone is out of the area, lending a helping hand to those who may not have the ability to complete certain tasks, or just being a friend when needed
- On some other topics, the home at lot 58 is and has been used by the Trash and Treasure Committee for many years for storing furniture for February's event, and will continue to be. However, no one is to drop off items at this location without first notifying the Trash and Treasure Committee, and also no items are to be placed there before September at the earliest.
- The painting of the exterior of the West Clubhouse, pump room and Office has been completed, and by the time you receive this, the painting of the exterior of the East Clubhouse will either be completed or well underway.
- Some in-house projects that are in progress or will be soon include the painting of the fence around the clothesline area at the West Clubhouse and repairs of the sidewalks as needed.
- Other projects include work on the East Clubhouse roof in order to prevent any future water damage that may flow into the interior of the clubhouse, and work on some of the water pipes, most notably at the area around Prince Oak and Serendip.
- Also you may by this time note some changes in the front of the Park as Serendipity has been working with the Serendipity Plaza to resolve the issue regarding the large cedar trees in the front. This change should benefit everyone as you are either coming into or exiting your community. Also, three oak trees that are on the Plaza side of the fence but hang over homes at the front of your community are to be removed if they haven't been already.
- Thanks again to all for making Serendipity the place that it is, Have a Safe Fourth and a Great July!
