# **Manager's Corner for May 2015**

- Just another reminder of Rule # 10 of Serendipity's Rules and Regulations, which states in part the following: "All lot rental amounts are payable in advance the first day of every month and are delinquent if not paid by the fifth (5th) day of any month in which the lot rent is due. All lot rental amounts paid after the fifth of the month will be subject to a late fee as specified in the Park Prospectus. The current late fee amount is \$25.00.
- Another rule reminder pertains to Rule #19, which states in part the following: "The speed limit in the park is 10 miles per hour. Automobile horns are not permitted to be sounded in the Park except in cases of emergency. Automobiles must be parked in the driveway of your lot and are not allowed to park on the roads overnight or on lawns at any time. Automobiles may be parked overnight at the east and west clubhouse parking areas". If there are any questions regarding these or any other of the Park's Rules and Regulations, please contact the office.
- By the time you receive this Newsletter, a new home should be in place at Lot 97. If you or anyone you know may be interested in purchasing this home, please stop by the office for more details, or just call the number that will be included on the "For Sale" attached to the home.
- The renovation of the West Clubhouse should be underway sometime during the summer, but at the time of this writing no determination has yet been made as to ROC Board approval for the final design or the contractor to be used.
- As a preventive measure, any areas that are showing wear and tear on the East Clubhouse roof will be addressed sometime in late April or May. This will be an ongoing project in order to keep rain from leaking into the interior of this facility.
- There still is time to sign up for the Tie Down Program, so contact the office to get the forms that need to be completed. This project is tentatively scheduled to commence sometime in October. We will keep you posted.
- The street lines and speed bumps will be getting a fresh coat of paint sometime in the very near future, so be extra cautious as you drive the streets of the community. You will be seeing red cones in different areas at different times.
- That's it for now so want to wish everyone a safe and happy May and the beginning of unofficial Summer time on Memorial Day. (Of course as we all know summertime in Florida is already here.

census shows a population of 57,439. The area covers 26.6 square miles – 17.4 square miles of land and 9.2 square miles of water. Palm Harbor has a unique "hilly" geography which is uncommon in the relatively flat Florida. Palm Harbor is noted for excellent schools, rated "A" by the state.

Mild winters with lots of sunshine and summers tempered by the cool long breezes from the Gulf of Mexico make Palm Harbor a pleasant choice. Temperatures average 64F in winter and about 81F in the summer. The average annual rainfall is 50 inches, with most falling in late afternoon thundershowers from June through September.

# **History**

People began occupying the area now known as Palm Harbor as early as 1860. It was a pioneer town, a farming center, a developer's dream, a resort town and a college town. The year round warm weather made the area conducive to farming, citrus groves and fishing. Warm mineral springs gave birth to spas and health resorts.

Between 1864 and 1925, Palm Harbor has had several names: Bay St. Joseph, Yellow Bluff, Ozona, Sutherland and finally Palm Harbor in 1925. One of the first settlers was J.C. Craver. According to his diary, he came here in the winter of 1877 upon the advice of his physician. Craver built his first cottage and began fishing, farming, ranching and harvesting timbers in a heavily forester area between Yellow Bluff and Lake Butler. (Yellow Bluff later became known as Ozona (pure air) and Lake Butler was later called Lake Tarpon.)

A post office commission under the name of Bay St. Joseph was granted in 1878, this being the earliest written record of the community. In 1883, Craver received a homestead for 160 acres and opened a general post office and store near the present day Tampa Road and County Road 1. The community became Sutherland, a shortening of Southern Land and Development Company, the group that originally platted the community as Sutherland, Hillsborough County, in 1888.

The railroad came through in 1888 and began bringing tourists to the area. Sutherland boasted two beautiful hotels. The San Marino hotel became Southern College in 1902 and sat on a high bluff overlooking Sutherland Bayou and the Gulf of Mexico.

# Cultural

Although mostly a residential community, downtown Palm Harbor (U.S. Alt. 19 & Omaha Street) hosts many small shops and restaurants along with some historic buildings. Most of the commerce is located along U.S. Highway 19. To step back in time, stroll down Florida Avenue and enjoy the quaint shops and restaurants. Visit the North Pinellas Historical Museum at the corner of Curlew and Belcher Roads.

The downtown area hosts many festivals and craft fairs. One popular event is the "First Friday Celebrations" held the first Friday of every month. There is entertainment for children as well as crafts and food. The "Taste of Palm Harbor" is held the first Sunday in October with live music and food from local restaurants. Check out the popular Palm Harbor Citrus Festival.

# Recreation

There are many parks in or near Palm Harbor. John Chesnut Park is located in the East Lake region on the eastern shore of Lake Tarpon. It contains boat ramps, nature trails and thousands of feet of boardwalks around the lake. "Pop" Stansell Park overlooks St. Joseph's Sound and



has five wooded acres with covered picnic pavilions and a fishing pier. Wall Springs Park is located directly on the Pinellas Trail just north of Crystal Beach. Anderson Park is located on U.S. 19 on Lake Tarpon. It's a large shady park with covered picnic areas, a boat ramp and a playground. Other nearby are Fred Howard Park in Tarpon Springs and Honeymoon Island and Caledesi Parks on the Gulf. Steve Putnam Park has sports fields, tennis courts and a playground. The Sunderman Recreation Complex has baseball fields, batting cages, hockey rink, beach volleyball courts and golf training areas. Don't forget about the Pinellas Trail. This County-wide linear park runs from Tarpon Springs to St. Petersburg. The paved path is used by bicyclist, skaters and walkers during daylight hours.

There are plenty of big-time sports events located nearby in Tampa: Tampa Bay Buccaneers, Tampa Bay Rays, Tampa Bay Lightning and the Tampa Bay Storm. Grapefruit League Spring Training nearby hosts the Philadelphia Phillies, the Toronto Blue Jays, the New York Yankees, the Clearwater Threshers and the Tampa Bay Devil Rays. The area is also host to National sports events such as the Outback Bowl, the Verizon Golf Classic and St. Anthony's Triathlon.

With nearly 365 days of sunshine here, most days encourage the enjoyment of outdoor recreation. The area offers both fresh and saltwater fishing opportunities in Lake Tarpon and the Gulf of Mexico. Water sports enthusiasts can water ski, jet ski or cruise/sail either in the Bay, Lake Tarpon or the Gulf. Locally you will find our white sand beaches are ranked in the top ten in the U.S.A.




