Notes from the monthly meeting with ELS:
Hoping everyone is enjoying Fall and you are healthy and safe.

- The HOA rent negotiating committee was able to get ELS to lower the rent to a 4 % increase for leases that are a September 1 date. This year it started on October 1 because covid delayed getting everything ready on time. It will end on August 31,2021. Some Mobile Home parks used for the comparison were less rent and some more. Many do not have the amenities we have. If anyone is interested in getting involved in the rent negotiations and wants to join the committee please let a board member know.
- Rent checks can still be deposited in the drop box at the office during business hours. If you want a receipt they will get it to you. You need an appointment to go in the office so call ahead if you need to see someone.
- Lawn service contract is pending but we are told the vendor will change. There are still plans to trim palm trees and remove offending fruit trees. NO new fruit trees can be planted. If you have complaints about the lawn or trash service please contact them directly so the companies know that the residents are unhappy. If the service is the same another time call the office and they will then make a call.

THE CURIOSITY CORNER

Battle of Anacostia Flats

The United States, wanting to show its appreciation towards the veterans of WW I, passed on May 19, 1924 the World War Adjusted Compensation Act or Bonus Act. This act promised veterans of WW I a bonus, “credit”, based on where they served and length of service between April 5, 1917 and July 1, 1919. One dollar (\$1.00) for each day served in the United States and \$1.25 for each day overseas, with a maximum of \$500 within the US and \$625 for overseas service. Certificates were to be issued on one’s birthday and no earlier than January 1, 1925 and redeemable on their

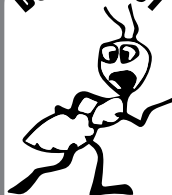

birthday in 1945. Most officers and anyone enlisted after November 11, 1918 were excluded. Veterans were able to take loans against the certificate value and by June 30, 1932, 2.5 million veterans had borrowed approximately 1.370 billion dollars.

After the end of the war in 1918, the country's economy began to hum, creating prosperity for most of the population in the US, the period between 1920 –1929, became known as the Roaring Twenties. During this period many individuals who were willing to accept some risk placed their savings in the stock market. The promise of increased return on their money and many rags to riches stories made it difficult to pass up for many individuals. The market became a scene of wild speculation. The market rapidly expanded during the 20's but began to slow with the economy entering a mild recession in 1929. Consumer spending slowed which eventually reduced factory production due to their inability to sell excess product. Stock values however continued to rise eventually reaching grotesquely overvalued prices.

On October 24, 1929 the market began selling the overpriced stock. A record 12.9 million shares were traded and the day became known as "Black Thursday." Then five days later, on October 29th, an additional 16 million shares were traded, "Black Tuesday." The market continued a slower but downward slide for several more weeks. Consumer confidence fell with the market, spending slowed to a crawl and factories began firing workers, wages fell and inflation followed. Those noted two days destroyed the world economy. Worldwide domestic product fell approximately 15%. During the Great Recession of 2008-2009 GDP fell less than 1%. Periods of inflation, deflation, and high unemployment ravaged heavily industrialized countries especially hard throughout the 1930s. The conditions in Germany, aggravated by the required war reparations of the Versailles Treaty, were especially harsh and the response by the German government helped bring Hitler to power in the mid-30s.

The US industry reduced wages, hours, or fired workers to keep from closing. Many companies closed their doors. The value of the dollar decreased and many, forced to buy on credit, fell into debt. Foreclosures and repossessions rose steadily forcing many into homelessness. The public started running on banks to withdraw their savings, forcing many to close. Many veterans of World War I suffered during this period and decided to petition Washington, the Hoover administration, for their promised bonus. Their efforts were unsuccessful.

In May of 1932, veterans decided to take a more active approach to impress upon congress the urgency of their request. Approximately 17,000 – 20,000 vets demanding immediate cash payment, and approximately 45,000 (reference estimates vary) additional protesters, descended on Washington D.C. They were called the Bonus Army or Bonus Marchers by the press, the marchers referred to themselves as the Bonus Expeditionary Force.

The marchers occupied any vacant federal building and also established two main camps, or shanty towns. They built shelters using packing boxes, old lumber, and scrapped tin from junk piles. The largest encampment of about 10,000 vets, called Hooverville, was located across the Anacostia River to the southeast of the capital, at Anacostia Flats. The veterans and D.C. police maintained order with orderly protest parades held daily.

On June 15, 1932 the House voted on a bill sponsored by Wright Patman (D-Texas) that would address many of the veterans concerns. The bill passed in the House but was soundly defeated by the Republican Senate two days later. President Hoover, becoming somewhat apprehensive about the large number of protesters camping so close to the capitol, ordered their peaceful removal.

On July 28th, under the command of Gen. Douglas MacArthur, more than two hundred

soldiers on horseback, plus men on foot and five tanks assembled on the Ellipse south of the White House. Thousands of workers reportedly left work and lined Pennsylvania Ave. to watch. The veterans thought that the troops were going to march in their honor. The veterans had been told to disperse but continued to hold their ground. Some marchers did heed the order and had already begun to leave until a group of hostile protestors started to hurl rocks and bricks at police. Truckloads of veterans crossed the bridge and were confronted by about 500 police.

MacArthur already had plans on how he would subdue a domestic rebellion and during this incident twice ignored the orders given by the President, such insubordination would get him fired by a future president. His adjutant, Dwight Eisenhower, cautioned him about his approach to the situation but, at 4:00 p.m. the order was given and 200 soldiers on horseback, commanded by Maj. George Patton, with sabers drawn moved down Pennsylvania Ave. towards the Capitol building. They jabbed anyone in their path. The infantry followed, wearing gas masks and throwing tear gas. The five light tanks followed behind the Calvary. They swiftly cleared the camp on Pennsylvania Ave. and headed to the communist encampment. Tanks rolled over shacks, protestors set fires and many ran with their belongings.

MacArthur then turned his attention to the Anacostia encampment. President Hoover sent Gen. George Mosely with a written message to MacArthur informing him not to evacuate the Anacostia camp and not cross the bridge. MacArthur ignored the message. He had tanks block the bridge so no one could leave. Then around midnight troops crossed the bridge and entered the camp lobbing tear gas and torched everything in sight. It was reported that the blaze lit up the night sky. At midnight, while the president was asleep MacArthur held a news conference. He accused the Bonus Army of subversion and that they intended to take over the government. Two veterans and two D.C. police officers died during the protest, 55 veterans were injured and 135 arrested.

Newspapers on the following day had a field day, photos of armed soldiers, cavalry and tanks routing unarmed veterans and civilians with fires everywhere. Presidential candidate Theodore Roosevelt stated that this event would give him the upcoming election. Although once in office he also opposed immediately paying the bonuses. He argued that it would be inflationary. However in 1936 Congress overrode his second veto and the bonuses were finally paid. Although for some it was too late. This bill became the forerunner of the G.I. Bill that would later make benefits available to returning veterans of World War II.

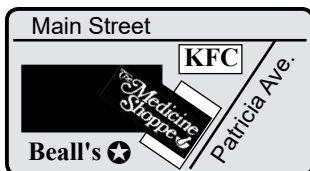

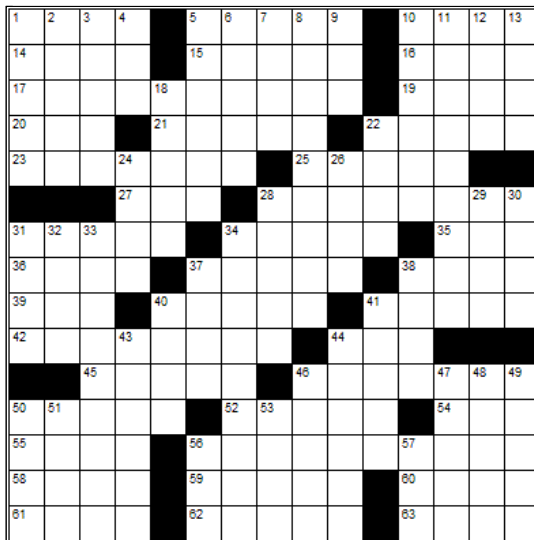
