# Manager's Corner for October 2015

- Just a reminder that the new lawn care providers, Matthew's, are mowing on Mondays, and will be doing this every Monday (weather permitting) through October 12th. At this point, they will start **MANAGER** cutting every other week and then reduce the number of cuts further during fall and winter. A (tentative) schedule for the end of this year and all of 2016 is posted on the bulletin board in the East Clubhouse.
- There is no update regarding the Tie-Down program. It is still scheduled to commence sometime in the middle of October, but the actual start date has still not been determined. If anyone is still interested in adding their home to this program, the forms that need completed are in the Office. Any new updates will be posted on the bulletin board in both clubhouses and on the electronic sign in the front area of the community.
- It is very early, and there will be plenty of reminders in future newsletters, but if you are looking to add your information or make changes to next year's Dial Directory (the Yellow Book), please let the office know.
- The renovation of the West clubhouse is moving along and if all goes according to schedule (how often does that happen?) the clubhouse will reopen sometime in mid-October.
- With the beginning of the fall/winter season and an influx of the seasonal residents, it is even more important that you are careful and observant as you are walking or driving in Serendipity and when you leave the Park. Please keep in mind Rule # 19 of your current Rules and Regulations state in part the following: "The speed limit in the Park is 10 miles per hour." Please be cautious and abide by the speed limit. It is there for your safety!
- As to current projects, we are still behind in what we were looking to accomplish by this time of year. Some projects that will be done soon (weather permitting) will be power washing of the common ground sidewalks that have become rust colored by all the rain, and the cleaning and painting of the street lines and speed humps, just to name a couple. Hopefully a drier season is on the horizon.
- Just want to welcome all the seasonal and new residents coming into the Park and wish everyone a wonderful October.

# **Honeymoon Island Update**

couple weeks ago I was out at HI to watch the sunset. We were at the area where the current groin is, near the Oasis parking lot. As we watched the lovely sunset, we also saw them pumping sand into the area by the North parking lot. It was a constant process and then bulldozers were leveling it out and pushing it where they wanted the sand to go. Just this past Friday (9/4), I was out for a day at the beach and I decided to walk up to the north area



where I had seen them pumping in the sand. When I got to the area, I was pleasantly surprised to see a beautiful WIDE beach. It was just amazing! Although there weren't many people at the beach that day, some had already discovered the "new" beautiful beach. For sure, that is where I will be on my next beach visit!

According to the TB Times, the construction crews will be

finishing up the project in April. Cranes have been hauling 3-5 ton granite rocks that are being used to build three T-groins. Tgroins are a kind of jetty that breaks wave energy and prevents the tide from pulling sand back out into the water. The stem runs under the sand and holds the groins in place with 3- to

5-ton rocks. Abreak in the structure

allows sand to continue to migrate naturally along the shoreline. They plan on filling in 149,000 cubic yards of sand which is being pumped from a shoal south of Hurricane Pass. The plan will add 150 feet of sand along a half-mile stretch of beach. Volunteers will plant beach flora supplied by the contractor.

In 2008, one T-groin was placed near the island's center parking lot. Constant wave action caused about 70 feet of the north parking area to crumble, lopping off 50-60 feet of that lot. You may remember that the bath house was moved back because it was going to fall into the ocean.

This improvement will be a boon to Florida's economy, which ranks beaches as the top tourist attraction. Honeymoon Island drew more than 1.1 million visitors last year.





## Trees of Many Colors

**7** ho wouldn't love to take a drive through the countryside and enjoy the beautiful foliage of autumn! I am certain if asked where the best autumn foliage is found, the answer would be wherever you may have lived or live. I grew up in Florida and we are definitely not known for our fall colors! But, I have lived in upper New York State and observed lovely fall color! It is truly magnificent. I am sure this can be said about all the northern states as well as the northwest.

Do you know why the leaves change color? You may remember the answer from your biology class (many moons ago?). The mixture of red, purple, orange and yellow is the result of chemical processes that take place in the tree as the seasons change from summer to winter. The food-making process takes place in the leaves which contain chlorophyll (gives the leaves its green color). Chlorophyll absorbs energy from sunlight that is used to transform carbon dioxide and water to carbohydrates. But, along with the green pigment are yellow to orange pigments. Most of the year other colors are masked by large amounts of green coloring.

In the fall, the changes in the length of daylight and temperature stop the foodmaking process. When the chlorophyll breaks down, the green color disappears, and you see the yellow to orange colors. Other changes occur at the same time, developing red to purplish pigments. Different trees show different colors. Maples have that brilliant orange but oaks are mostly brown. Some trees start out with one color and change into another or shades thereof. Here are some of the various colors of individual trees.

Most of the broad-leaved in the north shed their leaves in the fall. Some leaves stay on the tree and shed in the spring. In the south, where winters are mild, some trees keep their green color winter. Not all trees shed their leaves – the conifers (pines, spruces, firs, hemlocks, cedars) are evergreen in both the north and the south. Some of the individual needle-like leaves may stay on the tree for two to four or more years.

The best time to enjoy the autumn color would be on a clear, dry and cool day. Time is limited to enjoy the miracle of the fall colors!




