Dinosaurs may have been big softies

he popular image of dinosaurs is one of tough, ferocious creatures, but they may have been more sensitive than previously thought—at least their faces.

According to the Science News website, paleontologists at the University of Southampton used advanced X-ray and 3-D imaging to examine the skull of a large carnivorous land-based dinosaur found on the Isle of Wight and found that its snout may have actually been very tender—more like that of an aquatic creature. The dinosaur, a Neovenator, may have possessed pressure receptors in the skin of its snout, similar to those enabling crocodiles to forage in murky water.

Because scientists don't believe the Neovenator was a water feeder, they speculate the receptors may have been useful for picking meat from bones while eating and also stroking other dinosaur faces during mating.

What caused a massive extinction of sea life?

ost people know about the mass extinction of the dinosaurs millions of years ago, but paleontologists are hot the trail of another catastrophic event: the dying off by large marine animals 2-3 million years ago.

The extinction claimed the lives of up to one-third of marine megafauna, including water-based mammals, which lost 55 percent of their species. Forty-three percent of sea turtle species also died off, along with 33 percent of sea birds and 9 percent of sharks.

A team at the University of Zurich studying the event theorizes that a sudden loss of the productive coastal habitats combined with altered sea currents caused or contributed to the extinctions. The evidence suggests that large marine animals were more vulnerable to environmental changes than was previously believed.

Science is the acceptance of what works and the rejection of what does not. That needs more courage than we might think.

Three activities to ward off Alzheimer's

lzheimer's disease may not have a cure, but experts believe some practices can help delay memory loss. Here's what you can do:

- Cognitive training. Crossword puzzles and other games can help, but try some different techniques. Do simple arithmetic in your head instead of relying on a calculator. Develop a new method for remembering what's on your shopping list. Train your brain to remember things in new ways and you'll keep it sharper.
- Control your blood pressure. Reducing high blood pressure with medication and weight loss not only cuts your risk of heart disease, but it can also ease stress on the delicate blood vessels in your brain—stress that can exacerbate memory loss and dementia.
- Exercise. Moderate aerobic exercise has many health benefits, including heading off symptoms associated with Alzheimer's. Try exercising for 30 minutes five days a week, or 50 minutes three times a week. You'll feel better and extend your cognitive health.

Scientists search for life on the toughest planets

The think of life as viable only on planets orbiting stars like our sun, but scientists now speculate that it could evolve on worlds circling very different types of stars.

Stars called M dwarfs are the most common stars in our galaxy. Their harsh flares and gravitational grip on their innermost planets could interfere with the formation of liquid water, which is necessary for life. However, astronomers have spotted approximately 200 planets circling M dwarfs, and dozens are in the so-called habitable zone where liquid water could exist and temperatures aren't too extreme for the development of life.



Scientists are studying these strange new worlds in hopes of detecting conditions that might lead to life—although it will probably be very different from any life found on Earth.

Lost and found: Seeking owner of ancient sword

Significant cientists are trying to determine the identity of the owner of a 14th-century sword found in a bog in Poland. The four-foot-long sword, which according to the Fox News website is remarkably well preserved, was discovered by a worker using an excavator to drain a peat bog. The worker donated his find to a local museum.

Museum officials speculate that the sword was lost by a medieval knight, or that perhaps the knight perished in the bog. Researchers are examining an engraving on the sword's hilt that may identify the knight or his family. Meanwhile, archeologists are searching the bog for other artifacts.

A new trend: Traveling in search of good food

Traveling to see the wonders of world is always popular, but these days more and more people are heading out to try exotic foods. A survey by the American Automobile Association found that 22 million Americans are planning to take a food-based vacation in the next 12 months, and 75 percent of Americans say that food and drink are an important part of their travel experiences. Four out of five say they've traveled to visit wineries and distilleries, along with taking hands-on cooking classes and eating with local families.

Credit card debt growing in the U.S.

mericans added \$89.4 billion to their credit card debt in 2016, according to the WalletHub website, and although they repaid \$31.5 billion during the first quarter of 2017, that's still 9 percent less than they did during the first quarter of 2015 (but 14 percent higher than in 2016).



People tend to pay down credit card debt early in the year thanks to year-end bonuses and New Year's resolutions. WalletHub projects that Americans will finish 2017 with more than \$60 billion in new credit card debt, for a total of more than \$1 trillion overall.

Men, women, and smartphones

ere's more evidence that we're addicted to our smartphones: A survey from Decluttr. com revealed the following factoids:

- Men are four times more likely than women to use their smartphones during a wedding.
- Sixty-seven percent of men check out their devices during a romantic evening, but only 13 percent of women do.
- Twice as many women than men would rather give up sex than give up their phone.
- Smartphone owners look at their phones more when they're with friends than with their family, but men do so more than women on either occasion.
- Eighty-three of men say the worst part about not having their smartphone with them is not being able to watch videos or stream movies and TV shows, although just 17 percent of women say the same.

Facts about the bills in your wallet

ou don't have to be a millionaire to know the value of a dollar. Here are some facts about paper money from the U.S. Bureau of Engraving and Printing website:

- The first \$1 bill was issued by the government in 1862 with a picture of Treasury Secretary Salmon P. Chase. George Washington's portrait first appeared on the \$1 note in 1869.
- **Dollar bills** account for approximately 45 percent of all U.S. currency production.

• The lifespan of a \$1 Reserve note is about 21 months. Other bills have different life expectancies.

• The first \$2 bill was issued in 1862 and featured a picture of Alexander Hamilton, the first Secretary of the Treasury.

- The first \$100 bills were issued in 1862, with a picture of the American bald eagle. Benjamin Franklin's portrait first appear on the Series 1914 Federal Reserve Note.
- The lifespan of the average \$100 note is 89 months.





Questions can expand your perceptions

ne of the world's most famous paintings is "The Night Watch," by Rembrandt. When curators hung it in Amsterdam's Rijksmuseum, they conducted an experiment: They asked museum visitors to write down questions they had about the painting. The questions they received were varied: How much did the painting cost? Had it ever been forged? Are there any mistakes in the painting? Why did Rembrandt choose this subject to paint? Who were the people in the painting?

The curators then posted the questions, and the answers, in a room next to the gallery where the painting hung. Visitors had to walk through that room to view the painting.

Curators found to their surprise that the average length of time visitors spent looking at the painting jumped from about six minutes to half an hour.

Art lovers walked back and forth, reading questions and examining the painting. They told museum officials that reading the questions encouraged them to look closer and longer and to remember more details.

How to spot ADHD

ttention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder is an increasingly common and somewhat perplexing behavior problem. How do you know whether your child has ADHD or is simply going through a rough stage? Here are some clues and what your pediatrician should do:

Symptoms:

- Inattention. Your child seems not to listen often, makes careless mistakes, and fails to give attention to details; fails to follow through on directions; is forgetful in daily activities; and avoids or dislikes tasks that require sustained mental effort, such as homework.
- Hyperactive. Your child fidgets often, gets up from the seat in the classroom when he or she should be sitting down, and talks excessively.
- Impulsive. Your child often has difficulty waiting for his turn and butts into conversations or games.

What your pediatrician should look for:

- The symptoms should be present in at least two settings, like home and school, and should have persisted for at least six months.
- Doctors should look for the specific symptoms outlined by the American Academy of Pediatrics and the American Psychiatric Association.
- Doctors should talk extensively with both parents and teachers.
- Doctors should also investigate other conditions. About one-third of children with ADHD also have anxiety or depression disorders.
