





Choose the right mindset for creative success

Your mindset influences your ability to think creatively and succeed in whatever you do. Here are four basic mindsets to cultivate, from the MakeIt website:

o you feel like you're not really making any progress on your goals? Try this: Write a letter to yourself.



In the letter, envision what you would like to accomplish in one year's time. Let your mind create the situation as if it has already happened. Make sure you write about where you are in relation to the dreams you have for yourself.

Seal the letter and give it to someone you trust completely. Ask that person to mail the letter back to you in one year's time. Measure how much progress you've really made to realize your dream.

Many people who try this exercise find that they have moved significantly from where they were a year prior and are making steady progress toward their goals.

World Alzheimer's Day, Sept. 21. An international campaign to raise awareness and challenge the stigma that surrounds dementia.

The history of Labor Day

abor Day is a creation of the labor movement, a yearly celebration of the American worker, and a national tribute to the laborer's contribution to the social and economic achievements of the United States. There is some uncertainty about the origins of Labor Day. Some records show that Peter J. McGuire, general secretary of the Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners and a co-founder of the American Federation of Labor, was first to suggest a day to honor those "who from rude nature have delved and carved all the grandeur we behold." Other research suggests that machinist Matthew Maguire, later the secretary of Local 344 of the



International Association of Machinists in Paterson, N.J., proposed the holiday in 1882 while serving as secretary of the Central Labor Union in New York.

The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, Sept. 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. In 1884, the first Monday in September was selected as the official holiday. The first governmental recognition of Labor Day came through municipal ordinances passed in 1885 and 1886. The state of Oregon passed the first law recognizing the Labor Day holiday on Feb. 21, 1887. Four more states—Colorado, Massachusetts, New Jersey, and New York—followed suit that same year. On June 28, 1894, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September of each year a legal holiday in all the states, the District of Columbia, and all U.S. territories.

Craft a story for innovation

ou have to create a narrative for innovation, according to Michael Margolis on the Your Story website. Margolis, CEO and founder of strategic messaging firm Storied, which specializes in stories of innovation and disruption, has advised clients across 34 industries and 15 countries, including Google, Hulu, and NASA. His advice:



- Set the context. Describe the vision you're working toward. Identify the changes you want to see, and seek out fresh perspectives. Focus on users' needs. Slow down and avoid complexity. Make your vision compelling.
- **Inject emotion.** Make the customer the hero of your story by describing their desires and dilemmas. Add conflict and suspense. Show the inner and outer characteristics of your heroes and villains to make them real people.
- **Show evidence**. Present the research behind your story—pilot projects, demos, metrics, testimonials and personal stories, and historical precedent. Show how they validate your story and the impact your solution can have.

Happy marriages spur creativity

A happy marriage leads to greater innovation on the job, according to a study by the Hong Kong Baptist University, reported on Fox Business.

The study analyzed how workers' personal relationships affect their innovation and creativity. Researchers found a "positive spillover of psychological resources into their work"— and the effect is magnified when employees' spouses are happy as well. Employees in unhappy relationship experience depleted psychological resources.

One caveat: The researchers found that with people who are already naturally creative, the impact of a happy relationship had less of an effect.

The researchers suggest that employers offer family-friendly policies, such as anniversary leave, relationship counseling services, and work/life balance initiatives.

The desire to create is one of the deepest yearnings of the human soul.


