FURRY FRIENDS CORNER

FOODS TO AVOID GIVING YOUR PET

Ithough FiFi and Fido are going to try to convince you otherwise, there are many "people" foods that can cause sickness and even death for cats and dogs.

Alcohol - Alcoholic beverages and any products that contain alcohol should never be given

to your pet. Alcohol can cause symptoms anywhere from vomiting and diarrhea, to central nervous system depression, coma and even death.

Chocolate, Coffee and Caffeine – As with alcohol, these foods/beverages can cause serious symptoms including tremors, seizures and possibly death.

Coconut and Coconut Oil – You've probably heard the newest diet/health fad is coconut oil. I've read that coconut oil, when given in your pet's food, is great for them. However, according to the ASPCA, when given in higher amounts, coconut oil can cause stomach upset, loose stools and diarrhea. Also, coconut water should never be given to your pet as it contains high amounts of potassium.

Grapes & Raisins – Grapes and raisins can cause kidney failure in dogs.

Nuts—Macadamia nuts can cause weakness, depression, vomiting, tremors and hyperthermia in dogs. are more susceptible than dogs, these vegetables and herbs can cause gastrointestinal irritation and can lead to red blood cell damage. Signs usually appear within 12 hours and can last up to 48 hours. Almonds, pecans and walnuts contain large amounts of fat, so these should also be avoided. A couple of peanuts, or a little peanut butter is okay, just go easy because of the salt in the peanuts. It's also not a good idea to give your pets salty snacks like chips and popcorn. The salt isn't good for you and definitely not good for your pets.

Onions, Garlic & Chives – Although cats

Xylitol – Xylitol is a sweetener which is used in many products, including gum, candy, baked goods and toothpaste. In cats and dogs, it can lead to liver failure.

Yeast Dough – Yeast dough can rise and cause gas to accumulate in your pet's digestive system. This can be painful and can cause the stomach to bloat, and potentially twist, becoming a life threatening emergency.

Also, remember to keep your medications out of reach of your pets. Some medications, including anti-depressants can be very harmful to your pets. If you are going to give your dog an over the counter medication, such as benadryl, melatonin (for anxiety), aspirin, etc., please consult your veterinarian first. Benadryl can be helpful with allergies in dogs, but you need to be very careful with the amount given, and make sure your dog is in excellent health first. Melatonin can be helpful with anxiety, such as thunder and loud noises, but again, check with your vet first to make sure you are giving the correct amount. I really don't like giving any kind of aspirin, even baby aspirin, as it can be very tough on a dog's stomach.





Check medical bills with care

ealing with health insurance claims can be frustrating and time-consuming. Multiple bills from different departments for what seems like one medical procedure can baffle even the most organized consumer. The key is to keep track of insurance claims and keep detailed records. Follow this advice:

- **Review records**. Verify that the medical provider has the correct billing information. Also, check the identification or group number of your insurance plan on claim forms.
- Follow up to be sure the claim is being processed. Contact the provider or insurer after receiving a bill to confirm receipt. Write down the names of everyone you speak to, noting the date of the call and any available confirmation numbers.
- **Verify all the expenses.** Check to see if you are being billed twice. Similarly, verify that the contracted rate between the insurer and the provider is actually what you are being billed for.

Revamp your finances to save more money

If you can figure out how to save just \$125 per month, then set up an automatic savings to a mutual fund that yields an average of 7 percent, in five years you will have almost \$9,000. In 20 years, that amount will have grown to \$65,000! Here are four suggestions for coming up with that \$125 per month:

• Look at your cable TV bill. Do you need all those channels? You can roll your bill back by getting rid of premium channels or subscribing to a smaller, cheaper package.

- Stop picking up magazines from the supermarket or newsstand. Save yourself some money by reading online or subscribing to your favorite magazine instead. And if you're subscribing to anything you don't read, cancel it.
- Change your cell service. Shopping around can get you a better deal that will save you bucks. Just make sure you won't be penalized for breaking a contract early.
- Call your credit card company. You may be able to get a lower interest rate just by asking.
