### Hash

- Leftover cooked meats (Ham, Pork, or Beef)
- Leftover cooked Potatoes, carrots, onions

Grind all leftovers in a food processor. Heat Oil in a skillet with minced garlic. Add the ground leftovers. If it is too dry, add a little chicken broth a little at a time to moisten. Turn with Spatula to brown on both sides.

## The history of Black History Month

Woodson. Born to former slaves, Woodson worked hard and against the tide of prejudice to obtain his own education. In earning his doctorate from Harvard, Woodson was disturbed to find that during his studies, history books virtually ignored the black American population. So he decided to take on the challenge of writing black Americans into the history books.

He established the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History (now called the Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History) in 1915, and a year later founded the widely respected Journal of Negro History. Then in 1926, he launched Negro History Week, the precursor to Black History Month, as an initiative to bring national attention to the contributions of black people throughout American history.

February was chosen as Black History Month for the significant events and people who figured prominently in black American history. For example:

- Feb. 23, 1868: Civil rights leader and co-founder of the NAACP, W.E.B. DuBois, was born.
- Feb. 3, 1870: The 15th Amendment was passed, granting blacks the right to vote.
- Feb. 25, 1870: The first black U.S. senator, Hiram R. Revels (1822-1901), took his oath of office.
- Feb. 12, 1909: The National Association for the Advancement of Colored People was founded by a group of concerned black and white citizens in New York City.
- Feb. 1, 1960: A group of black Greensboro, North Carolina, college students began a sitin at a segregated Woolworth's lunch counter. The event marks a watershed moment in the civil-rights movement.





### **How TB changed our culture**

U.S. now, its impact is still felt today. Here are few ways, according to "The Forgotten Plague," a PBS television series, it continues to influence U.S. culture:

- Ice cream cones. Waffle cones to hold ice cream were developed to replace the small glass containers vendors served ice cream in at the beginning of the 20th century. Customers would return the bowls for reuse, but concern about germs generated the need for something that would reduce the possibility of contagion.
- Short skirts. Long women's skirts that dragged on the ground could easily pick up germs from the streets, especially since spitting was once considered socially acceptable until concerns about disease rose. Women quickly adopted skirts and dresses with shorter hemlines that reduced the danger of picking up unwanted germs and bacteria.
- Shaving. Long beards and mustaches for men were considered stylish, but again, worries about the germs they could carry changed people's minds. The clean-shaven look caught on and became a symbol of the rising middle class.

### Start your day with a breakfast that counts

Preakfast is the most important meal of the day, many experts (and moms) say, so nutrition and good choices in the morning are key to a healthy lifestyle. Keep these tips in mind to start your day off right:

- Don't skip it. You may think you're too busy or you'll save on calories. In reality, you may not have the energy you need to get going, and you'll probably be more tempted by snacks later in the day.
- Watch the sugar. A food labeled "low fat" may be high in sugar content (yogurt, for example). Juices and coffee drinks can be loaded with extra sugar as well. Keep an eye on unwanted sugar so you don't absorb needless calories—and crash later in the day.
- Get lots of protein. If you put milk on your cereal, remember to drink all of it instead of dumping it in the sink when you're finished eating. Otherwise, try a hard-boiled egg, or spread some peanut butter on your toast.
- Get plenty of fiber. Fiber makes you feel full longer. Bran flakes or an oat bran muffin (without too much sugar) can give you what you need. You can also add chia seeds or ground flax seeds to your cereal.





"Even if we don't dig all the way to the other side, look what we found along the way!"
