#### **Baked Beans**

- 2 lb. beans or 1 large can Grandma Bown's beans
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 package Lipton onion soup mix
- ½ cup water
- 1 cup catsup
- ½ cup light molasses
- 1 package bacon
- A little extra catsup

Put beans in baking pan. Put onion, soup mix, water, and 1 cup catsup in frying pan. Heat and simmer for a few minutes. Pour molasses and a little catsup over beans. Add hot mixture and stir well. Cover with strips of bacon and bake uncovered. Bake at 325° for 1½ to 2 hours. Beans will not get mushy or dry out.
