

Manager's Corner

It's great to see all of you returning to the park. The weather is beautiful. As we prepare for the upcoming holidays and New Year ahead, please join us in sprucing up the property and maintaining the community.

PARKING: Do not park golf carts or cars on, or straddling, the sidewalk. **Street parking is only allowed to accommodate carport or unit maintenance.** You can only park the number of vehicles (cars/golf carts/bicycles, etc....) that will fit in the carport. Also, there is no parking in any neighbor's driveway without written permission of the neighbor.

WATER BILLING: It is very important that you check in and out at the park office in order to adjust billing for your water payments.

SPEEDING: Slow Down. The Speed limit in the park is 10 M.P.H. For the safety of all residents and guests in the park, be sure to look both ways when coming out of side streets, and stop at the stop signs.

EXTERIOR HOME CHANGES: Prior to any work; all exterior changes to your home must be approved on a Request for Approval form, available at the Office. Many projects need a building permit and applications can't be finalized until the permit is obtained. You may call the City, or check online, for projects requiring a permit.

CAR REGISTRATION: Resident's vehicles must be registered at the Park Office and display a decal indicating the vehicle is approved to be in the community. Please come to the Office to pick up your sticker if you have not already done so.

GOLF CART RESTRICTIONS: Remember that only licensed drivers are allowed to drive golf carts, and you must be at least 16 years of age. Do not park golf carts on the sidewalks or grass. Golf carts must use lights at night and obey the 10 MPH speed limit.

PROPER ATTIRE: Please abide by the Park rules requiring men to wear t-shirts or button up shirts and ladies to have cover ups over bathing suits when you leave your property. Also, dry clothing, including shoes, is required when entering the club house.

PALM TREE INSTALLATION: Please contact the office if you are interested in having the Association plant a new Foxtail Palm in the exact location where a palm tree was removed from your property line due to age, decease, etc. Contact Cary or Jan at 727.577.0287.

DO NOT FEED STRAY ANIMALS: Sec. 14-30. - Public Nuisance Feeding Animals: A citation or \$148 fine for a violation of this section may be issued based upon: (4) Placing food or garbage, allowing the placement of food or garbage, or offering food or garbage in such a manner that it attracts cats, dogs, raccoons, coyotes or other wildlife, thereby creating a public nuisance animal.

Safety Tips:

- Call the police immediately if you witness any suspicious activity at all! Be prepared to give as many details as possible. The Pinellas Park Police non-emergency phone number is 727-369-7864. Call 911 (in dire emergencies.)
- Keep outside lights during hours of darkness, every night.
- Lock your cars. Don't leave anything in your vehicle that you don't want to lose. Never hide a spare set of keys anywhere in your vehicle.
- Keep your outdoor shed locked at all times.
- Never open your door to someone you do not know, or solicitors.
- No one under age of 16 allowed to drive golf carts!
- LOOK OUT FOR ONE ANOTHER.

Lift Station Monthly Reminder – Important

Submitted from the Office

LUSH ONLY: Body waste and toilet paper. It is highly recommended that only one ply toilet paper be used to prevent clogging the toilet.

DON'T FLUSH: Tampons- Sanitary Pads – Diapers – Depends – Swiffer Cloths – Dust Cloths – Wet Wipes – Kleenex – Food, etc.

When we flush, the waste goes into a **holding tank** that has two pumps to expel the waste **<u>UP</u>** and **<u>OUT</u>** into the Pinellas Park sewage system. When any of the above gets flushed, it clogs the pump, overheats it, and burns out the motor.








Person of Interest


