TMHA MESSAGE

Treetings, I have been asked by members of the board to explain how to handle personal concerns/complaint's In Teakwood Village.



- 1. The person with the concern must try to settle the concern themselves by talking to the resident or business that they are concerned with.
- 2. If unable to settle the dispute, the person making the complaint must then write out a complaint form, (these are at the clubhouse) or any director may have one for you. These forms should state the issue, time or date of occurrence and the complainant must either sign his/her name or phone number. This is to be able to contact you once we get an answer from John Houle.
- 3. If the complainant refuses to do the above, the board will not file the complaint with John Houle. Mr. Houle has instructed us in the past that without a name or phone number he would not address the complaint. Your name will not be associated with the complaint.

Mr. Houle doesn't want the board to come to him with complaints filed by board members unless the board member is directly effected by the issue.

This process has worked well in the past and it stops frivolous complaints.

Now that the restrictions have been lifted from the pool and the clubhouses please continue to practice social distancing and if you are using the exercise equipment please sanitize it before and after you use it.

have a couple of things this month and I am just trying to figure out which comes first. Both are very important. Ok we will start with a review of and changes to trash pickup.

- 1. Household trash/garbage to be picked up Mondays and Thursdays.
- 2. Lawn trimmings must be bagged or bundled and will be picked up on Thursdays.
- 3. Furniture is picked up by regular trash pickup on Thursdays.
- 4. Construction material, such as flooring, toilets, etc., are not picked up by trash service. Please contact main office and have a small dumpster delivered to your home for renovation material disposal. Teakwood only has 2 of these dumpsters so please be patient.
- 5. Electronics (TVs, computers, etc.), chemicals, paint are no longer being picked up by Teakwood Village. You will need to take the items to Household Electronics and Chemical Collection Center at 2855 109th Ave. N, St Petersburg. They are open Monday – Saturday 7AM to 5PM. You can get a map and directions along with what to take and quantities of items and dates and locations of Mobile Collection Sites at their website http://www.pinellascounty.org/solidwaste/hec3/default.htm.
- 6. And as always, any questions can be directed to the main office 727-584-8684.

As of June 1, the clubhouses reopened and restrictions on numbers lifted at the pools. Please note that Pinellas County is still social distancing, so take heed with the number of people in the pools and pool areas as well as the clubhouses to ensure that there is room for the social distance to keep everyone safe.



IT'S TIME TO BE COOL AT THE POOL

t is that time of year when it gets hot, hot, hot! Everyone wants to stay cool and everyone wants to go to the pool. Please keep in mind this is a "community" pool. Not your own personal backyard pool.

Many of our residents use the pool for therapy. Walking, exercising, floating and relaxing. This is hard to do with children

running, screaming, jumping and splashing in the pool. If you have visiting friends and family, you must accompany them to the pool. Remind them they are a guest and should behave accordingly. Just like visiting someone's home, treat the pool area with respect. Be mindful that this is a shared amenity. The same with the hot tub. Hot tubs are not safe for children—it is not a big bathtub. If your family and friends enjoy the water and do not want to share the pool with residents, remember, there are miles of beaches less than four miles away that you can go to. Each day the chairs are all nicely aligned and arranged. At the end of the day chairs are scat-

tered all about. If you line your chair back up at the end of use, this helps the maintenance person in the morning, and it prevents people from walking through a maze of chairs to get to the hot tub or shower.

I know cell phones are a convenience and they are nice to have with you in case of an emergency but really, do you need to sit in the pool talking on your phone so we all have to hear your conversations? Is it necessary to have the phone on speaker so we know all about your latest doctor appointment and all the details of your personal medical history? As a courtesy to others, please keep your phones out of the pool.

If you are with friends and family, please don't have conversations by shouting across the pool. In this time of social distancing six feet apart is a reasonable length so there shouldn't be a need for yelling. The same goes for music. It is nice sometimes to enjoy a little music at the pool. But not everyone feels that way. Play your music so you can hear it (or if possible, use earbuds). If you want to blare it and share it, ask those around you if they mind.

Recently we have had drinking at the pool and hot tub; A gentleman who saw fit to put one of the deck chairs in the water to sit on; children running, jumping and screaming and disturbing the residents who are there to enjoy the pool. This is not okay. Pool and Spa rules are posted—please respect them and the residents who are mindful of those they share the pool with.

One last thing, this is summer. Afternoon thunderstorms can pop up at a moment's notice. If you hear thunder, please get out of the pool. Florida is the lightening capital of the world. "If Thunder Roars, Get Indoors." You can get struck by lightning within 20 miles of a clap of thunder! So, this summer be courteous, be smart, be safe, stay cool and enjoy the pool!!!

- $2\ 1/2\ c.$ shredded cheddar cheese
- 1/2 c. butter softened
- 5 Tbsp half & half
- 1 tsp. Kosher salt
- 1 1/2 c. Flour
- 1 1/2 c. Grated Parmesan
- 3 Tbsp finely chopped fresh basil
 - 1. Preheat oven to 350 F
 - 2. Beat cheddar cheese, butter, half & half, salt at med. speed with a mixer until blended.
 - 3. Gradually add flour, Parmesan cheese & basil, beating until just combined.
 - 4. Turn dough onto a well-floured surface. Divide into 3 equal portions & roll to flatten each to 1/8 inch thickness. Cut with a star-shaped cutter. Place 1 inch apart on parchment-lined baking sheets.

5. Bake 11 - 14 min. or until golden; cool on baking sheets on wire racks for 30 min.
