reetings, welcome back to our northern friends. There was an article in the Largo Leader Newspaper that says that Mobile home parks are a breeding ground for code violations, unlicensed contractors and unsafe practices. Mobile homes are considered vehicles in the state of Florida, which means that the Florida Building Code that are used for standards of living really don't come into effect. They are vehicles and because of that, we are limited in what we can do sometimes within the structure.

Therefore, work inside units doesn't need permits, paving the way for unlicensed contractors. We are getting ready to come into the season where we're going to have all kinds of unlicensed, unlawful contractors, and inside the mobile home parks is where they do a lot of business. Please, if you are going to add some upgrades to your mobiles, be aware of who you hire. Make sure they have the proper licenses to perform the work you want done, otherwise you may not have any recourse for a settlement.

The tree trimming should be done. I talked with Linda, one of the owners, she was concerned and apologized because it was taking longer than anticipated. The previous tree service didn't cut the stems properly so her crew had to do double the work. I think they are doing a great job and so do most of the residents.

**<u>URGENT NOTICE!</u>**: on October 11th I received a call from a resident that there was an individual going house to house trying to sell a TV service in the park saying he was connected with the park and had the parks approval, not so. Neither the owners nor the Board of Directors ever give anyone the right to solicit any kind of service. I was told he was at a residence in

the park. I went there and confronted this salesman and explained who I was and asked why he was in the park. He lied to me and told me he was approved to be in the park. After further questioning he revealed that the company had sent him. I took him to the gate and told him not to come back. Please do not allow anyone in your house if you did not call for them to come.

As I have been doing, I searched back thru the messages, etc. for the past month and noticed something odd, so it has become the topic for this month's "From the Main Office".

How do I report a rules and regulations violation, you might ask? First these reports must be to the main office (727-584-8684 or tkwdllf@aol.com). You may put them in writing and mail them or drop them off. In the sales and main offices, we have a form you can pick up, complete and return. If you are unsure if something is a violation, give me a call at the main office and I can let you know on that.

The form has space for your information. I will need your name, address and telephone number. Should there be any questions that I have to complete the notice to the violator, I need a way to contact you. Teakwood Village does not take anonymous reports. We do keep your name out of it unless the issue escalates to our attorneys and then he will need the info to contact you for your eyewitness account.

About a month after reporting, if the violation is still happening, contact the main office and lodge a second report. This way if someone is disregarding the notices, we can escalate the matter. If too much time has elapsed, we have to start from scratch.

Remember all reports to the Main Office.


Suse is looking forward to spending more time in Florida. Susanne enjoys the diversity of the residents who live in Teakwood as well as what a close knit community it is.

## A couple of recipes which use leftover turkey from your Thanksgiving feast!

## Turkey-Mushroom Pasta with Maple-Cream Sauce

Servings 6 (1 cup each)

- 2 cups fresh cremini or button mushrooms, thinly sliced
- 2 med leeks, trimmed & thinly sliced
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 Tbsp olive oil
- 6 ounces dried linguine or spaghetti
- 2 med parsnips, peeled & cut into julienne strips ( 2 cups )
- 3/4 cup half & half
- 1/4 cup maple syrup
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 2 cups coarsely shredded cooked turkey
- 1 1/2 tsp dried sage, crushed
- 3 slices bacon, crumbled
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 1. In a very large nonstick skillet cook mushrooms, leeks & garlic in hot oil over med heat about 6 min or until mushrooms are tender & leeks are starting to brown, stirring occasionally.
- 2. Meanwhile, cook pasta according to package directions, adding parsnips for the last 4 min of cooking time. Drain & keep warm.
- 3. Add half & half, syrup & salt to the mushroom mixture in skillet. Cook & stir until just boiling. Add turkey, sage & drained pasta mixture. Cook & toss for 2 3 min to heat through. Remove from the heat.
- 4. Divide pasta among 6 serving plates. Top with bacon & sprinkle with pepper.

## TURKEY PIE IN A PAN

Makes 4 - 6 servings

- 5 Tbsp olive oil, divided
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1/2 carrot, diced
- 1 rib celery, diced
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 cups button mushrooms, quartered
- Salt & pepper
- 2 tsp fresh rosemary leaves
- 1/2 tsp dried thyme
- 1/4 cup flour
- 1 cup chicken or turkey broth
- 1 cup milk
- 1/2 tsp paprika
- 2 cups diced, cooked turkey
- 1 frozen puff pastry sheet, thawed
- 1 egg
- 1. In large ovenproof saucepan, heat 1 Tbsp oil over med high heat; cook onion, carrot, celery & garlic, stirring often until mixture starts to soften, 4 5 min. Add mush-rooms; cook, stirring, until they are lightly golden, 3 4 min. Season with salt & pepper. Stir in rosemary & thyme. Remove from pan & set aside.
- In same saucepan, whisk together remaining olive oil & flour over med heat, whisking constantly until mixture starts to brown, about 2 min. Slowly pour in broth & milk, whisking until smooth. Stir in paprika; simmer, stirring often until sauce is thickened, 3 4 min. Gently stir in turkey & reserved vegetable mixture; remove from heat.
- 3. Preheat oven to 400F. On lightly floured work surface, roll out puff pastry into 12 inch square. Cut into 3 inch squares. In small bowl, whisk egg with 1 Tbsp water. Place pastry squares on top of turkey mixture, overlapping slightly. Brush egg mixture over pastry squares.
- Place saucepan on baking sheet; bake until filling is bubbling & pastry is puffed up & golden, 25 35 min. Let stand 10 min before serving.


