TMHA MESSAGE

reetings. I hope everyone had a satisfying Thanksgiving and wishing you a very Merry Christmas. The Board of Directors (BOD) has been working very hard on making amendments to our bylaws to bring them up to date. Our Secretary, Sharon Miller, will be posting them at the clubhouses for you to view. You, the members, will be voting to accept the amended bylaws at our next Annual Meeting.

As you all know, we are under an emergency shutdown and will be for some time. The FMO or Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, has issued a "HOA EMERGENCY POWERS/BYLAWS" directive stating, "It is our attorney's opinion that we can rely on the "Not-for-Profit" laws, in Section 617.0207, F.S., (Emergency Bylaws) and section 617.0303, F.S., (Emergency Powers) to allow 723 HOAs to operate their Association.

The BODs have agreed to comply. This has been accomplished by amending the By-Laws of the HOA to include the stated provisions of Section 617, plus specific solutions to these problems. In this regard, we are advising our members that the BODs are declaring an "emergency "and under the Emergency Powers, we adopted By-Laws that would initiate a "stand in place" for the remainder of 2020 and 2021.

Simply stated, annual elections, Open Meetings, and large gatherings would be postponed for a year. The effect would be that the same Board, it's officers, and committees, would continue in place until the end of 2021. Vacancies that might occur during this period would be filled by the Board. The bylaws shall remain in effect during any emergency, and upon termination of the emergency, the emergency bylaws will cease to operate.

TMHA BY-LAWS AMMENDMENTS (PART 1):

AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE, SECTIONS AT 2022 ANNUAL MEETING

ARTICLE II POWERS

Amend to: The Directors of this Association and the operation of the Association itself shall be governed by the By-Laws. The Association has the power to negotiate for, acquire, and operate the park on behalf of the mobile homeowners, and to act on behalf of its members in dealings with the owners and operators of the Park. All meetings with the park owner shall consist of a minimum of two (2) Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IV MEETINGS OF MEMBERS

Amend to: SECTION 2. ANNUAL MEETINGS. The annual meeting of the Association shall be held on the first or second week of February each year. At the annual meeting the members shall elect a Board of Directors in accordance with these By-Laws and shall transact other business. If the annual meetings has not been called and held within six (6) months after the time designated for the annual meeting, then any member or members may call a meeting.

Amend to: SECTION 5. NOTICE OF MEETINGS. A written or printed notice of meetings, stating the place, day and hour of the meetings and in the case of a special meeting, the purpose of the meeting shall be given by the secretary of the Association, or by the person authorized to call the meeting to each member entitled to vote at the meeting.

Amend to: SECTION 6. AFFIRMATION NOTICE. An officer of the Association shall provide an Affidavit affirming that the notices posted in a conspicuous place on the park property, in accordance with Section 5 hereof, and said statement shall be filed in this Association's records.

Amend to: SECTION 8. VOTING RIGHTS AND REGULATIONS. In any regular or special membership meeting, the owners of a mobile home located on a lot in the Park (unit) shall be entitled to cast one (1) vote for each unit. When a unit is owned by one (1) person his or her right to vote shall be established by the record title of his unit. For the purposes of this paragraph, a purchaser under a Contract of Sale shall not be regarded as an owner. If a home is owned jointly, they may, without being required to do so, designate a voting member in the manner provided



above. If both owners are present at a meeting and concur, either one may vote for the home.

Amend to: SECTION 9. VOTING. A member entitled to vote may vote in person or absentee ballot.

Amended to: SECTION 10. QUORUM. The presence in person of a majority (50% + 1) of the members entitled to vote shall constitute a quorum at member meetings requiring a vote on any business of the Association. The exercise of the right to purchase the park as set forth in Chapter 723.071, Florida Statutes, requires a quorum to be a majority (50% + 1) of the members. Therefore all meetings of the members relating to the exercise of the rights provided in Chapter 723.071, Florida Statutes, the present in person of a majority (50% + 1) of the members entitled to vote shall constitute a quorum. All decisions or actions requiring a vote to be taken shall be made by a majority (50% + 1) of the quorum in attendance and the affirmative vote of those members present shall be the act of the Association. In those instances where there is a quorum present at the beginning any duly organized meeting, the members present can continue to do business until adjournment even though members have withdrawn from the meeting leaving less than a quorum present.

Meetings of members for informational, reporting and discussion purposes may be held without the presence of a quorum. No action or other business requiring the vote of members may be taken without the present of a quorum.

NOTE: Part 2 and Part 3 will be printed in the January and February 2021 newsletters. The complete document (3 pages) will be posted in all three clubhouses for review.

- as such, adheres to the requirements of the Housing for Older Persons Act of 1995. Consequently, at least 80 percent of the occupied units must be occupied by at least one person who is 55 years of age or older as of the date of occupancy.
- 2. The minimum age for all Residents is 45. Notwithstanding the minimum age requirements of this rule, Management reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to grant exceptions to the minimum age requirements of this Rule, while still maintaining compliance with the Housing for Older Persons Act of 1995.
- 3. All prospective Residents must complete an application for residency, which will include a background and credit check. Park Management reserves the right to refuse admittance to any prospective resident on the basis of the criteria established to determine the background, character, and financial responsibility of prospective Residents.
- 4. All prospective Residents and all existing Residents shall be required to produce for inspection and copying, one of the following age verification documents: driver's license; birth certificate; passport; immigration card; military identification; other valid local, state, national or international documents containing a birth date of comparable reliability or a certification in a lease, rental agreement, application, affidavit or other document signed by an adult member of a household asserting the age of occupants of said home.
- 5. On January 1st of each odd numbered year, all existing Residents shall be required to provide the names and ages of all current occupants of the unit, in writing, to Management. Failure to provide the written occupant documentation shall constitute a violation of these Rules and Regulations and the home owner may be subject to eviction pursuant to Section 723.061, Florida Statutes.

DINING OUT

pEGGtacular; 12125 Indian Rocks Road (in Harbor Crest shopping center); open 7 a.m. — 3 p.m. Monday through Sunday; dine in or carry-out. There are other Speggtacular restaurants in the area, but this is the only one I have been to. All carry the same menu but are individually owned so I can only comment on how great this place is.

If breakfast is your thing, this is a restaurant you must visit! I have been twice with my brother and already know what I am going to order the next time. The breakfast menu is so extensive, it would take close to a year of once weekly visits to try everything. So far I have had the 'Las Vegas Eggs Benedict' (Two poached eggs served with ham, tomatoes, asparagus and Swiss cheese, covered with hollandaise sauce and choice of bacon, sausage or ham) and 'The Princess' (3 plain crepes with blueberries, bananas, strawberries, raspberries and English cream). My brother had 'The Expert' (Three eggs, Bacon, Ham and Sausage, Home Fries, fresh Fruit and toast) and not feeling quite as hungry on our 2nd trip had 'Two eggs with choice of Bacon, Sausage or Ham' (Served with potatoes, fresh fruit and toast). The portions are large and the prices are very reasonable. I was so full each time that I skipped lunch. My brother urged me to try their fresh squeezed orange juice. The serving is so big we split an order – the cost was \$4. Most places have frozen concentrate orange juice and charge \$3.50 for 6 oz.

This is not a place to go to if you are in a hurry as everything is fresh and cooked to order. None of this pre-cooked and then warmed up nonsense at Speggtacular. Trust me, it is worth the wait. You can taste the freshness in each bite. My eggs benedict were perfectly poached and the hollandaise sauce was light and creamy. The asparagus was a little overcooked but that was the only flaw I have found in anything I ate. I am not fond of bananas, so the head cook left them off of my crepes and added more of the other fruits. All of the dishes were beautifully presented. I must pay special homage to the sausage. I could become seriously addicted to them. These are not the small grayish sausage links you see at most restaurants but rather they are plump, slightly crispy on the outside and juicy on the inside with the perfect blend of herbs and spices. Each time I take a bite of these I just have to smile, sometimes even giggle, as they make me feel so happy.

There are 3 small tables outside, inside the tables are nicely spaced out, and there is counter service. Will & I eat at the counter that faces the open kitchen which is spotless. The waitresses are friendly, helpful & efficient. You don't see plates sitting in the window for more than a few seconds before they are whisked away to the waiting customer. The lunch menu is smaller but has a variety of salads, sandwiches, wings and daily lunch specials from 11:00 - 3:00. Since living in Largo I have eaten at several restaurants that are open for only breakfast and lunch and I can honestly tell you this is the BEST!

A French Canadian tradition for Christmas Eve.

Ingredients:

- 4 onions, chopped
- 4 cloves garlic, finely chopped
- 3 Tbsp olive oil
- 3 lbs ground pork
- 3 lbs ground beef
- 4 potatoes, peeled & diced

- 1 c chicken broth
- 3/4 c breadcrumbs
- 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg
- 1/2 tsp ground cinnamon
- Salt & pepper
- 12 rolled-out pastry shells, homemade or store-bought
- 1. In a large saucepan, soften the onions & garlic in the oil. Add the meat & continue cooking about 15 min. stirring to crumble the meat. Season with salt & pepper. Add the remaining ingredients & cook, stirring frequently, for about 45 min. or until the potatoes begin to fall apart. Let cool. Adjust the seasoning. Cover & refrigerate for 4 hours or until completely chilled.
- 2. With the rack in the lowest position, preheat the oven to 375.
- 3. Line six 9 inch pie plates with pastry. Cover with the cooled meat mixture. Cover with a second crust. Make an incision in the centre. Press the lip to seal with a fork or your fingers. Bake for 50 min to 1 hr or until the crust is golden brown.
