



\*Learn a New Language. When international travel returns to normal wouldn't it be fun to plan a trip to a place where you could speak the language or at least a few words. Check out Rosetta Stone on-line at rosettastone.com/learn-language. They offer a free trial to get started. After that there is a fee. If you just want to learn a few words (for free) check out Duolingo. com. Exercising the brain is as important as exercising the body.

\*Stay Connected. Call a friend or neighbor to see how they are doing. We all need some social interaction and it is a good way to make sure those we care about are ok.



### **NEW SCAMS TO BE AWARE OF**

cams and cons are internationally based and are big business. Older Americans loose roughly \$3 billion to fraud each year. Here are some of the newer ones and what you can do to avoid being taken:

\*COVID-19 cons – You get an e-mail offering a coronavirus



\*Phishing Amazon – Scammers take advantage of the fact that so many Americans order online through Amazon. You'll be told, via e-mail that will at first glance look like it came from Amazon, that a package can't be delivered until you "confirm" your credit card number. Within the e-mail is a link that if opened places malware on your computer to harvest information. What to do: Don't give information via a link. Go to Amazon's website directly to contact their customer service group.

\*Census Scam – a fake census worker may contact you in person

or via, phone, e-mail or mail. You could be asked for your social security number or credit card information. What to do: The Census Bureau will never ask for your social security number or solicit donations via credit card or gift cards. They will never threaten you with arrest if you don't cooperate. Census takers carry government IDs. For more information visit 2020census.gov \*Economic Impact Act - The IRS urges taxpayers to be on the lookout for scam artists trying to use the economic impact payments as cover for schemes to steal personal information and money. Remember, the IRS will not call, text you, email you or contact you on social media asking for personal or bank account information. Also, watch out for emails with attachments or links claiming to have special information about economic impact payments or refunds. What to do: If a taxpayer is unsure they're receiving a legitimate letter, the IRS urges taxpayers to visit IRS.gov first to protect against scam artists.

There will always be a new scam on the horizon. Scammers can be very convincing and sometimes menacing. Do not give personal information such as social security number, medicare/medicaid number or credit card information to anyone over the phone that you have not checked out first. Do not send gift cards in order to redeem a prize.

# **SLOW THE SPREAD**

Listen to and follow the directions of your STATE AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES.

**IF YOU FEEL SICK**, stay home. Do not go to work. Contact your medical provider.

**IF YOUR CHILDREN ARE SICK**, keep them at home. Do not send them to school. Contact your medical provider.

**IF SOMEONE IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD HAS TESTED POSITIVE** for the coronavirus, keep the entire household at home. Do not go to work. Do not go to school. Contact your medical provider.

**IF YOU ARE AN OLDER PERSON,** stay home and away from other people.

**IF YOU ARE A PERSON WITH A SERIOUS UNDERLYING HEALTH CONDITION** that can put you at increased risk (for example, a condition that impairs your lung or heart function or weakens your immune system), stay home and away from other people.







### **RECIPES OF THE MONTH**

ay - a time to celebrate Mothers and signs of spring; rhubarb & asparagus.

One of my Mom's favorite holiday side dishes, spinach cheese tart, is included below as well as one of Liz's favorites, rhubarb custard pie. Enjoy!

### Spinach Cheese Tart

This spinach mixture can also be put in miniature tart shells & used as an appetizer. Pastry:

- 1 c. sifted AP flour
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/3 c lard or shortening
- 2 3 Tbsp cold water
- 1/2 c cheddar cheese, finely shredded, cut in with lard

Prepare pastry shell. Partially bake in a 9-inch pie pan for 8 min. at 450 F. Remove pastry shell from oven to a wire rack. Reduce oven temp. to 375 F.

### Filling:

- 3 c. cooked spinach, coarsely chopped (= to 3, 10 oz. bags raw spinach)
- 1/2 c. Parmesan cheese, shredded or 1/4 Parmesan + 1/4 cheddar
- 1/2 c. onion, minced
- 1/4 c. heavy cream
- 1/4 c. melted butter
- 1/2 c. cracker crumbs
- 2 Tbsp. melted butter

Mix the first 5 ingredients thoroughly. Turn into a partially baked pastry shell. Sprinkle with cracker crumb & butter mixture. Return to oven & bake for 15 min. at 375 F or until crumbs are golden brown & spinach mixture is heated through.



### **Rhubarb Custard Pie**

9-inch pie pan

Oven temps.

425 F for 20 min. - 400 F for 20 min. - 325 F for 15 - 20 min.

### Ingredients:

- Pastry for one pie shell
- 3 c. diced rhubarb
- 1/2 c. sugar
- 3 Tbsp flour

- 2 egg yolks
- 1 tsp. lemon extract (optional)
- Pinch of nutmeg
- 1 cup milk
- 1. Line pie pan with pastry. Fill with diced rhubarb.
- 2. Mix remaining ingredients in order given. Pour over rhubarb.
- 3. Bake at high temp for 20 min. Reduce heat & continue baking for 20 min.
- 4. Prepare meringue from 2 egg whites. Remove pie from oven & top with meringue.
- 5. Return to oven, reduce temperature to 325F. Bake until meringue is firm & golden brown.
