FEDERATION OF MANUFACTURED HOME OWNERS OF FLORIDA

Governor DeSantis has authorized \$120 million of the State of Florida's Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) allocation to assist Floridians that have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. It is intended for those struggling to pay housing expenses such as: rent, mortgage payments, and emergency repairs that will keep families stably and safely housed. This program may be used by manufactured home owners in land leased communities as well as for those directly renting manufactured homes. In general, your income must be no more than 1.2 times the median income for your area and your income has been adversely impacted by the Covid 19 pandemic. Additional details may be found online (https://www.floridahousing.org/docs/default-source/aboutflorida/coronavirus-relief-funds/homeowners_renters-faq.pdf?) or you can call Florida Housing's toll-free Coronavirus Relief Fund Information Line at 1-888-362-7885. <u>TEAKWOOD RULES AND REGULATIONS: Teakwood Mobile Home Association</u> It is the responsibility of all residents, whether year-round or seasonal, to abide by the Rules &

It is the responsibility of all residents, whether year-round or seasonal, to abide by the Rules & Regulations found in the Prospectus. This month <u>B. DEFINITIONS</u>

- 1. "Common Ground" or "Common Property" shall mean and refer to all real property (including improvements thereon) now or hereafter owned by the Park Owner (as defined herein below) which is not part of a Lot, or as to which the Park Owner has been granted easement rights, for the common uses and enjoyment of the Park's Residents and approved Guests and invitees.
- 2. "Guests" shall mean a non-resident whose stay at the request of a Mobile Home Owner does not exceed fifteen (15) consecutive days or thirty (30) days per year, unless such person has the written permission of the Park Owner or unless permitted by a properly promulgated rule or regulation. If a Guest's stay in the Park exceeds fifteen (15) consecutive days or a total of thirty (30) days in a year, the person is no longer considered a Guest and the Park Owner may charge the Mobile Home Owner extra rent as set forth in the approved

mobile home park prospectus for the Park. Pursuant to723.051(3), the spouse of a Mobile Home Owner is not considered a Guest.

- 3. "Lot" shall mean and refer to any Lot within the Park as shown on the Lot plans attached to the mobile home park prospectus as Exhibit A.
- 4. "Management" shall mean the Park Owner or Park Manager who has been appointed by the Park Owner to operate and supervise the Park



property.

- 5. "Mobile Home Owner" shall mean a person who owns a mobile home and rents or leases a Lot form the Park for residential use pursuant the Chapter 723 of the Florida Statues.
- 6. "Office" refers to Rent Collection Office or Sales Office as referenced in sections A.3 and A.4 herein.
- 7. "Park" shall mean the property owned by the Park Owner provided for the use of Mobile Home Owners and approved guests, visitors and invitees, known as Teakwood Village Mobile Home Park.
- 8. "Park Owner" means Houle Family Limited Partnership, A Florida Limited Partnership.
- 9. "Resident" is used herein to collectively refer to Mobile Home Owners, Tenants, Subtenants and all other persons approved by the Park Owner for residency in the park.
- 10. "Subtenant" shall mean a person who leases or rents a mobile home from a tenant.
- 11. "Tenant" shall mean a mobile home owner who rents a Lot from the Park Owner by signing a Rental Agreement to rent a Lot in the Park.

When enclosing part of your carport, adding a flower box, using lattice for privacy, putting up a flag pole, ok anything that is not your mobile home, you must make a drawing. It's ok for it to be just a line drawing, with a brief description of what you are wishing to do along with your name, address and telephone number and submit it to the Main Office for approval. This approval is just Teakwood Village saying we are ok with you doing the project. You will need to contact the City of Largo to see if they require a permit for the project. DO NOT START the project until you have received approval from Teakwood Village. If you do a project that has not been approved, Teakwood Village can/will make you remove the work at your expense. Also, we do not allow satellite dishes to be placed in the yards, you may attach them to your mobile home, but they cannot be placed in the yards. Sometime in the not so distant future we will be inspecting and having you remove any that are in the lawns.

Thank you in advance for making sure that all satellite dishes are not in yards. Remember you can always call the main office to double check on anything you wish to do. Stay safe and enjoy October.





My daughter, Debbie, & I ordered our CURBSIDE meals online. You can find ALOHAANSLEY online @ AlohaAnsley.com, where you'll find beautiful pictures of their menu items.

There are 4 varieties of gluten-free salads including these two we ordered:

Volcano Flow Salad (\$5.75) which consists of mixed greens, tomatoes, bell peppers, black bean corn salsa, guacamole, side of homemade Hawaiian BBQ dressing.

The Waikiki Salad (\$6.95) consists of mixed greens, quinoa, tomatoes, pineapple, mandarin oranges, pickled red onions, avocado, side of homemade pineapple vinaigrette. Both were fresh, refreshing & delicious.




