#### TMHA MESSAGE

reetings Teakwood. You all are aware of the pandemic and of our borders being closed and that our Canadian residents are not sure when they will be allowed to return. The (FMO) Florida Manufactured Home Association, has issued an HOA Emergency Powers/Bylaws provision under Chapter 617.0207 to consider declaring an "emergency" by which the BOD "Board Of Director's" would under its Emergency Powers, adopt Bylaws that would initiate a "stand in place" for the remainder of 2020 and 2021.

Simply stated, annual elections, Open Meetings, and large gatherings would be postponed for a year. The effect would be that the same Board, its officers, and committees would continue in place until the end of 2021. Vacancies that might occur during this period would be filled by the Board.

Any emergency bylaws so adopted, the bylaws of corporation shall remain in effect during any emergency, and upon the termination of the emergency, the emergency bylaws will cease to be operative. Hopefully, it will not come down to this, but as your elected HOA Representative it is my duty to inform you of this possibility.

As to the happenings or non-happenings in the Village, please just follow the rules in our Prospectus and Rules and Regulations package you received when you bought your home. This pandemic will pass in time and we will be able to resume our normal activities.

- 1. Welcome to Teakwood Village. Teakwood Village is privately owned and operated by the Houle Family Limited Partnership ("Park Owner"), a Florida limited partnership
- 2. These Rules and Regulations have been established by the Park Owner and shall apply to all Residents, their family and guests. The purpose of these Rules and Regulations is to help ensure that your residency is pleasant, safe and enjoyable. Many of the Rules and Regulations are based on requirements of Florida Laws and the remainder written to help in the protection of your safety, of your property, and your privacy. Consideration and courtesy to others plus your cooperation in maintaining an attractive home will sustain the high standards of Teakwood Village.
- 3. The Rent Collection office will be open for business Monday through Friday from the 1st day of each month until the 10th day of the month during the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (NOTE FROM EDITOR: If any residents pay their lot rent by check at the beginning of the month, there is now an available Dropbox outside the main office across Missouri Ave at Teakwood West) The office may be open other times at the discretion of Management. During any times the office is not open, the Park Owner may be reached by mail addressed to Teakwood Village, P.O. Box 838, Largo, FL 33779-0838. All payments of lot rental monies must be paid during the stated hours for Rent Collection offices. Complaints, notices, demands, requests for service and all other business must be mailed to our office at the address indicated. Please do not contact any other employees, except in cases of emergency. All employees are paid by Management and are not permitted to accept tips. We ask your cooperation in not offering tips for special services.
- 4. All Residents must register at the Sales Office upon arrival. Also, Residents must register their overnight Guests who remain in the community for five (5) days or longer. All registration shall be at the Sales Manager's office located in the recreation complex at Teakwood Village South (NOTE: next to the Tiki Hall).

I would like to talk about fireworks for a bit. It is against the law in Pinellas County to set off any fireworks that explode or launch into the air. You may use sparklers and fountains, but nothing that launches or explodes. If you have never rushed for your hose to put out the fire after your neighbor set off an illegal firework and it came down on your tree, this might seem silly. You cannot control the landing, so you are risking houses and landscaping. The penalty, if police come, is confiscation of the illegal fireworks, a fine and possible arrest. Teakwood Village is stating that fireworks are not to be set off inside the Park.

Mr. Houle thought about holding off on this as an article topic until December, but I know a lot of people will be itching for fireworks on Labor Day, so don't do it. Sparklers are fine, but don't set of noisy or exploding or launching fireworks!

I think I will save parking until next month, well just a reminder: NO street parking at all, NO parking at the clubhouses unless you are using them or have a permit, NO parking in guest parking unless you have a permit. Teakwood is inspecting and will give you one chance then you will be towed.





#### **COVID Q & A**

The following are excerpts from an article originally appearing on HuffPost. Huff Post hosted a COVID-19 Q & A with Dr. Kavita Patel, HuffPost's medical contributor and a practicing internal medicine physician in Washington, D.C., and Lindsay Holmes, HuffPost's senior wellness editor, to get answers during this confusing time.



#### 1. IS IT SAFE TO GO TO A RESTAURANT NOW?

Dr Patel: While there have been no reported cases of contracting the virus from prepared food, there have been case studies of spread from people inside of restaurants, particularly those with poor air circulation. It is important to make sure that any outdoor or indoor space has been observing physical distance, workers are wearing masks & washing hands. The safest option would be curbside or contactless delivery, outdoor dining next, and then limited indoor dining to places with confidence in air circulation, etc. If you are a high-risk person, it would be safest to avoid the physical location and contact altogether.

- 2. IS IT SAFE TO GO TO A SALON OR SPA RIGHT NOW?
  - Dr Patel: These services can be safe again if the precautions [like wearing face masks and hygienic practices] are taken. I would limit the service to those that are essential and would consider delaying optional services.
- 3. IS IT SAFE TO GO SWIMMING IN AN OUTDOOR POOL?
  - Dr Patel: Unfortunately, being outside in the water is not completely risk-free (neither is any activity around others, for that matter). However, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention states that there is currently no evidence that you can contract the corona virus from swimming in a pool.

The most important part is to maintain social distancing between yourself and people who are not in your household. Washing your hands frequently, especially after using a high-touch surface area like a railing, is also important.

Don't share pool floats, goggles or any other swimming equipment with others. Face masks are also still recommended if you're going to be in more public areas around other people but should be taken off once you're in the water (while you continue to maintain distance from others).

HuffPost: Experts are still learning about the novel coronavirus. This information is what was known or available at press time, it's possible guidance around COVID-19 could change as scientists discover more about it.. Please check the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for the most updated recommendations.

#### **RECIPES OF THE MONTH**

#### **Italian Shrimp Dish**

This dish includes zucchini, tomatoes & basil which are plentiful at this time of year. Makes 4 servings.

1 Tbsp olive oil

1 c chopped red onion

1 med. zucchini, chopped

3 tsp minced garlic

1/2 tsp dried oregano

1/2 c dry white wine

3 c chopped plum tomatoes

1 Tbsp balsamic vinegar


1/4 tsp each salt & freshly ground black pepper

1/4 c coarsely chopped fresh basil leaves

1 lb. uncooked large shrimp, peeled, deveined & tails removed

1/2 c crumbled feta cheese

1 Tbsp minced fresh parsley



2. Stir in basil & shrimp. Cook & stir until shrimp turns pink & no gray remains about 4 min. Be careful not to overcook shrimp or they will be rubbery. Remove from heat & sprinkle with feta cheese & parsley. Serve hot.





#### 7 Up Biscuits

These biscuits only need 4 ingredients & are super quick & easy to whip up! Makes 9 biscuits.


- 2 1/2 c baking mix ( such as Bisquick ), divided
- 1/2 c 7up or Sprite
- 1/2 c sour cream
- 1/4 c butter, melted
  - 1. Preheat oven to 450.
  - 2. In a med sized bowl, stir together 2 c of baking mix, soda & sour cream until just combined.
  - 3. Sprinkle the countertop with 1/4 c baking mix & place the dough out onto it. Sprinkle the remaining 1/4 c baking mix on top of the dough as needed, using your hands to mix into the dough & pat the dough out to about 1/2 inch thick. Add additional Bisquick as needed to form a very soft dough that is just holding together.
  - 4. Pour the melted butter into an 8 x 8 baking dish. Cut out the biscuits & place them in the pan of butter. You could also add garlic or herbs to the butter to have flavored biscuits.
  - 5. Bake for 12 15 min or until golden brown & cooked through.


