My 1956 Plymouth

Ralph has a new toy.....a 1956 Plymouth Belvedere with a 277 cu. in. V8 engine with only 44,000 original miles. This car had been previously re-furbished to its present pristine condition, and it gleams like a brand new car. All the doors, fenders, trunk, and hood were removed and the entire chassis was refinished . After I got it, I removed, re-cored, and flow/flushed the radiator and heater core. I had the intake manifold removed and replaced the mating engine gasket. I removed and chrome plated both valve covers, to make the car go faster. (If you believe that!!!)

In 1956, no cars, including my Plymouth, were equipped with air conditioning. This was a big problem for me and Kathy. During the recent New England hot summer, the car became uncomfortable and unfit for use. As a result, after searching the internet , I found an after-market air conditioning unit. After mounting the compressor, condenser, evaporator, fan, and all the high pressure hoses, the system was filled with freon and blew cold air. What a relief!

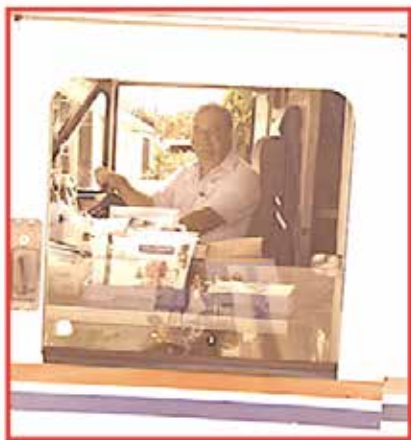
HOLIDAY DECORATING OF THE CLUBHOUSE

It's the way Dad reaches over for Mom's hand during Mass or even now when they're sitting together at rehab or in the hospital. It's a love that has endured the test of time.

I am so blessed and honored to be here to witness this love during their most trying time as a couple.

This is the first major illness to hit either of my parents. The way my Dad NEEDS my Mom is so stirring. The panic when he thought he wouldn't be able to see her every day and hold her hand. The way he talks about her to me when she's not there. He needed help this year with his anniversary card and roses that he always gets her. So he had me get them this year. He signed the card and approved the roses. He teared up when telling me how grateful he is for the amazing woman that is his wife. How lucky he is to have her. Until these past 3 weeks, I'd seen my Dad cry maybe 4 times. Now it's every time he talks about my Mom and how incredible she is and what she means to him. It's humbling to watch and listen to.

Then there's my Mom. This incredibly strong woman who has the most beautiful soul and giving heart and is always on the move and working on something. Watching her navigate this new life with a sick spouse is inspiring. You know she's worried sick and afraid of what the future holds and if she can manage once Dad comes home, yet she doesn't let it show. She's not one to whine or cry about a bad situation. She won't cry on your shoulder, she will pull out her rosary and pray until she is at peace and has renewed strength. My Mom is a caregiver with friends, strangers, family and now my Dad.

My parents may not have realized how closely they were being watched or even if we paid attention to these small details. We have. We may not have been able to replicate what they have, but we've tried.

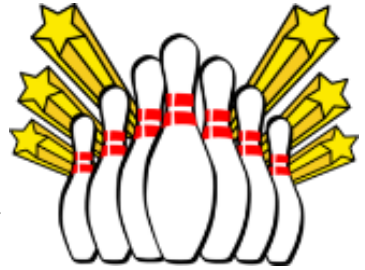
BOWLING

Well, I hope you are **Hunky Dory** after you read this and chuckle.

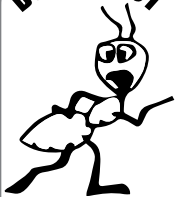
