



Packages, Packages. Many of our Lincolnshire residents have not been getting their packages delivered directly to their homes. There is a 3<sup>rd</sup> party delivery company called SpeedX that has been leaving resident packages correctly labeled with their lot#'s in our mailroom/laundry room. The week of February 1<sup>st</sup> alone there were 3 days that this editor was aware that a total of 15 packages on 3 different days were left in the mailroom and not delivered directly to the residents. After some research SpeedX a national shipping company that delivers for many vendors but based on what I saw TEMU seems use them a lot.

The return address on the package shows SpeedX with various addresses across the country. Keep the label on your package if this happens to you and reach out to SpeedX and let them know about the delivery situation. Maybe they can look into who they hired to deliver for them and get the problem corrected. Most vendors you order from will send you via text or email the tracking # on the package when it is shipped. Keep that information. You can track SpeedX packages online if you are able to do so.

Please remember that not all our residents have their mail delivered directly to their homes. Many of us go to the mailroom everyday to pick up our mail. The US Post Office is the only entity allowed to open and leave packages in the larger boxes in the mailroom. If you see packages left in the mailroom/laundry room when you pick up your mail take a moment to photograph or write down the name on the label. If you are able to maybe you can deliver the package or phone the resident and let them know it is there. If you ordered something and have not received it and you are a resident that gets their mail delivered directly to your home, take a ride up to the mailroom/laundry room and see if it was possibly left there. I don't know how we can solve this problem it has been going on for some time, they had previously been leaving the packages in the clubhouse outside the Manager's office.





Whenever you take trash to the compactor, please remember to close the door after depositing your garbage. **DO NOT PRESS THE RED BUTTON.** This compactor is pre-programmed to automatically start compaction after the door has been closed three (3) times. **It is very important that the compactor door is CLOSED after you deposit your garbage.** Do not throw large items into the compactor. You will need to wait till the bulk trash container is brought into the community each month. See Voice calendar for dates dumpster is scheduled each month.

Don't forget to break down your cardboard boxes before throwing them in the mixed recycle bins. If the recycling bins are full do not overfill them, the lids should be able to lay flat. Put your recycled items in the compactor instead. When the city comes to take the recycling bins all the "over" loaded trash ends up on our streets. **Please! Please! Think before you overload those containers.**

Please do not bring large items furniture etc. that need to be placed in the Bulk dumpster that is brought into the community twice a month. Check the Voice calendar for dates each month and hold those large items at your home till the container is brought on site.

Help us keep our compactor working by following the rules above.







### News and Updates for March 2026:

Tips on successful community along with our tenet association updates on living in Lincolnshire. LHOA protects your rights under Federal and State laws and also reminds homeowners of our responsibilities too.

- Driving safely in our streets (they are not regular city streets though numbered) involves keeping our speed down, slowing down and stopping at the park's stop signs and using lights (head and taillights) from dusk to dawn. These elements of safety involve vehicles, motor bikes, golf carts, electric scooters, and electric/manual peddling bicycles. Please do not endanger yourself or anyone else.
- The LHOA Board will continue Board and homeowner (whenever possible) discussions evaluating the success and the intended purpose of our four recycling bins located next to the compactor. Despite repeated actions to ensure the recycling bins are used properly all four become contaminated before each pickup. Unsanitary along with biohazard refuse is dumped. Several years ago, homeowners requested LHOA to work with the park owner and management on placing recycle bins by the compactor area. The park owner made accommodation for those bins. Unless there is a dramatic change in how they are used they can be removed allowing homeowners to take what they want to various recycling local locations. Residents living in close proximity to those bins, especially during the warmest part of the years deal with strewn waste, smell, and an unsanitary area. Homeowners wanted them and now must change their behavior.
- LHOA membership drive continues for 2026. \$15 for both new members and renewals. Membership funds not only support yearly Florida non-profit corporation operating costs but also keep the reserve fund strong to ensure that LHOA has the resources to meet our State FS 723 mandates and obligations to homeowners.
- ❖ The annual LHOA Member/shareholder meeting followed by the monthly LHOA Board of Directors Meeting is Wednesday March 11th right after the Wednesday Resident's Club coffee for residents. Members and homeowners are always welcome to attend.
- ❖ The LHOA Board is responsive to emails (Gmail address is above). Officers and Directors are listed on the inside cover of the monthly Voice.
- ❖ LHOA actively supports the FMO (Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida.) They are our primary lobbying agents promoting tenet rights in over fifty-five rental home communities to the Florida Legislature in Tallahassee. (<https://www.fmo.org/login#/login>). Often, there are articles posted on the LHOA bulletin board to keep all homeowners informed. Take a look.

As I told you at one of the coffee hours that I will try to do stories on Historical events. How many of you know Paul Davis at Lot 159? I was amazed at his family tree and his lineages on both sides of his family. He has shared genealogical paperwork with me to verify all the information is correct and it is amazing.

On both sides of his family His grandmother was Mildred Pauline Osborne, and his grandfather was Farley Damron Davis. He had 8 direct Great Grandfathers who served in the American Revolutionary War.

His family line originated in Virginia, and he is registered with the Sons of the American Revolution through Stephen Osbourne. He also had a Great Uncle, John Damon who fought in the Revolutionary War and a Great Grandfather John Phelps who severed on the House of Burgesses in VA alongside Peter Jefferson the father of Thomas Jefferson and Augustine Washington the father of George Washington.

How many of us can say that their family had a settlement named after them, the Osborne settlement in VA. Peter Jefferson and his father were born near the Osborne settlement. Both the Osbornes and the Jeffersons and the Bolling's and the Randolphs are all famous names from history and are all from VA. Paul's great Uncle John Bolling was married to Mary Martha Jefferson, the sister of Thomas Jefferson.

Not many of us can say that their relatives fought alongside Daniel Boone his descendant Cornelius Alexanader Robert did and fought alongside LT Daniel Boone in the same regiment during Lord Dunmore's war in 1774 against the Shawnee Indians, Robert's and Boone became good friends.

In more recent times Paul's father Rodney Davis, served in the USAF for 22 years (RET), and his brother Rick Rene Davis, served in the US Navy for 4 years. Paul himself was drafted for the Vietnam War and was not accepted due to his deafness.

I thank Paul for allowing me to capture just a part of his genealogical History and I hope you enjoy it as much as I did. You just never know the history of the neighbors that you live with every day.

# A NURSE'S SELF CARE TOOLBOX

There are considerable advertisements both on social media and television advertising on the newest weight loss medications along with also the value for Type 2 diabetics. We simply cannot escape them either. As a former diabetic and nutrition education nurse, I see both the pros and cons. They can be remarkably effective when used for the right reasons, for the right patient and prescribed by a monitoring medical provider. Both for diabetic control and non-diabetic weight loss.

Let us start with a stark reminder that about 40% of adults in the United States are carrying too much weight, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimates. Starting for many as an adolescent. And close to 45% of people fifty-five and older in Florida are obese. Seems moving here is not a cure though the weather can make it easier to reduce the percentage. Let us get outside as we cannot slip on the ice.

There are current medications that stimulate our pancreas to produce more insulin and/or help the insulin increase the sugar getting into all our body cells, even fat cells. Newer oral medications alter how the sugar from food breaks down in our small intestine. Injectable insulin is simply providing that essential hormone for those who do not make any or others who need that boost. Insulin combinations (short burst and later another slower burst) are quite common. We now have pen like injectables with precise dials for the correct dose. Oh, and needles (including those used for spot sugar levels) that a mosquito would be envious of.


The newest injectables we see advertised provide a more immediate and dramatic process of reducing the breakdown of food into sugar which is absorbed into our blood system. The results can be remarkable. Less sugar in the blood and our bodies' own regulating system (why we stayed alive during famines) begins to breakdown body fat into sugar (storage to market and use by our cells.) Often blood sugar levels including A1C's decline plus loss of weight!

For Type 2 Diabetics these new injectables can reduce sugar breakdown and absorption and provide helpful weight loss. However, there are always obstacles (cost), lack of a medical provider to monitor, limited supply for long term use, sham online marketeers of non-regulated or FDA approved suppliers (extreme risk), other and little guidance on weaning off these medications and continuing the other Diabetic care routines of proper eating and movement.

Also, and though seemingly unimportant to many, are the physical results of dramatic weight loss. Our skin over the years as stretched everywhere. Losing significant weight over a brief period of time does lead to sagging skin which can and often does affect our physical appearance.

Next month I will try to explain more about the difficulties of their use. My first warning until then is do not order these online unless you have gotten a prescription from your physician and then only from an actual pharmacy. Until then chew well.
