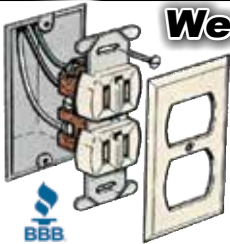

We have had several new residents join us this year, some permanently and some that were just visiting for a few months. I hope everyone took the opportunity to make some new friends and acquaintances. The Co-Op has established new committees to help with communications, our infrastructure and any beautification issues. As always, if anyone has any recommendations on how to improve Paradise, please submit your suggestions.

We are looking forward to a great summer for all, no matter where you decide to spend it. For those leaving, whether that is for 2 weeks or several months, please secure your homes, to prepare for those possible summer storms. Some home owners offer their neighbor the use of their driveways, this makes your home look occupied / watched over and also helps with less overnight street parking (giving better access for any emergency services), just a mutually beneficial thing to consider. Please make sure the office and others have your latest emergency contact information.

The common areas of our community should be considered an extension of your home and management just simply asks for your help to take care of it, and to take pride in it. STOP going into the clubhouse soaking wet from the pool, which makes the floors all wet, creating a hazard for your friends and neighbors. There are a mop and bucket in the ice/storage room, please cleanup after yourself if you do have some kind of accident. You wouldn't walk into

Residents that want to sell their homes will still choose their own realtor, but all realtors need to be connected to an off-site realty office. The IITS former staff members have connected with other real-estate agencies, so you can still use them or any other agencies you choose, there just isn't any physical onsite offices allowed. The Co-Op is investigating possible methods for us to better aid both, the sellers to advertise and the potential buyers to discover our sellers and to fully promote the benefits of living in the Paradise Island community.

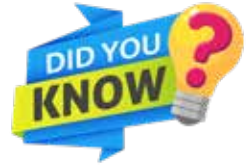
We are also working with the Church in the Park to upgrade the sound system to improve the quality of event presentation, in particular Bingo. This should be complete this month.

- **The One Call System** is the primary Resident Notification Tool utilized for immediate communication. Messages can be received via phone call, or text, and/or email. If you are not on One Call, please update your Contact Information Form at the office to request One-Call Messages.
- **The Spectrum Cable & WIFI amenity**, in addition to the significant number of available channels, also provides residents with many streaming services for free. These include *Disney+ (which includes Hulu & ESPN), Peacock, HBO Max, Paramount+, ESPN, and AMC*. Log in to your account on the Spectrum website using your Spectrum credentials. Navigate to "*Services*" or "*TV Streaming*". You'll see icons for the streaming platforms included with our TV package. If you have any issues with access/ setup, please contact Spectrum for assistance at 1-833-697-7328 (Bulk Account). Please take advantage of and enjoy these added services.
- **Your PI Account Information is available online** for your review and to make online payments as needed. Also, resident forms and documents are available. Log in to resourcepropertymgmt.com, click *Vantaca Home or Owner login*, and enter your email address. If you encounter any difficulties, instructions are on the screen to help you. For sign-in problems, please call RPM at 727-581-2662.
- **You need to notify the Park Office of your change of address when you leave for the season and then upon your return.** This provides direct delivery of important mail from Paradise Island Co-Op, eliminating delays caused by mail forwarding or missing critical mailings delivered to your address here instead of where you are located. Contact information forms for address/phone number changes are available at the office, on the Paradise Island Website, and online at the Resource Property Management Portal.
- **If you are leaving your home for an extended period**, as many of our snowbird friends do, please plan to have your home kept clean and neat while you are away. Remember that during our Florida summers and all the rain that comes along with it, everything grows about 4 times as fast as it does during the winter months when you are here in Paradise! And we think the weeds might grow ten times faster!!
- **The updated Rules & Regulations became effective March 1, 2026.** Please take time to review them. If you rent your home, please ensure your tenants are given an updated copy.
- **There is a Suggestion Box** in the clubhouse and at the park office. Your suggestions and feedback are important; we want to hear from you! Please offer a suggestion(s); your ideas count!

The Paradise Island Flea Market was a resounding success on March 28! We had over 75 volunteers who stepped up. An event of this magnitude cannot happen without them. We hit record sales, bringing in approximately \$9,500. After expenses, we netted around \$8,300 for our community!

So many of our residents, including the Men's Club and Maintenance guys, volunteered to help store items during the year, set up the clubhouse, empty the sheds, pick up tons of items around PI, unbox/untote everything, get them on tables and priced, donate baked goods, manage our 50/50, item and cake raffles, manage early bird entry, manage sales at over 60 tables, act as "bankers" for all of our money, provide a golf cart shuttle, put up and take down signs, and buy food and drinks for volunteers for both days. After the flea market, volunteers boxed up unbought items and stored them in the sheds, cleaned tables and got them set back up, took trash away, etc. It is a massive undertaking to pull this event off, and our residents showed up with smiles and a can-do attitude.

A big shout out to everyone who managed the tables. Here is how the break-down came out: Early Bird Entry \$224; Bake Sale \$372; Jewelry/Purses \$420; Furniture \$919; Artwork/Lamps/Rugs \$383; Tools \$586; Kitchen/Glassware/Dishes \$555; Small Appliances & Electronics \$719; Item Raffle \$464; 50/50 Raffle \$431; Books/Music \$205; Miscellaneous \$185; Clothing \$799; Linens \$379; Holiday Decor \$173; Games/Toys \$56; Home Decor \$473; Vintage/Collectibles \$445; Health & Medical \$98; Pets \$151; Sports \$213; Outdoor/Garden/Baskets \$150. The rest of the money was raised by selling items on Facebook Marketplace between October and March.

Again, Liz and I send a heart-felt thank you to EVERYONE who volunteered, no matter what role you played! Now we have a new goal to beat next year!

VETERAN'S CORNER

Most Vietnam veterans have fascinating stories about their time in the war, whether they're tinged with trauma, courage, hope and sadness. But for Marine Corps veteran Frank E. Cius Jr., his story is one of captivity and torture, spending over six years stripped of his freedom as a prisoner of war (POW).



Cius spoke of his time in Vietnam during an event to honor National Vietnam War Veterans Day in Buffalo, New York, this year, according to WIVB.com. Cius, who grew up in Buffalo, enlisted in the Marine Corps in the late 1960s and was assigned to the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing.

The young soldier knew his life would change when he received orders for Vietnam but had no idea what was truly in store for him. "Most of the guys in my squadron who came over with me were from our local area," Cius told a group of veterans at Buffalo Naval Park.

Like so many other POWs, Cius's will to survive kept him going, even though the darkest days. Cius will always recall June 3, 1967. That's the day the helicopter mission he was on did not proceed as planned. "On the return mission in, we lost three choppers," Cius said. "Now the mission turns into a rescue." Flying over Laos, his unit's CH46A helicopter was hit by a barrage of bullets from enemy forces. "We took the heaviest fire I have ever encountered in my entire life," Cius, serving as a door gunner, recalled. The chopper spun out of control, hover-rotated in the sky, before crashing down in a place Cius and his crew wanted no part of. "We crashed into the jungle, I thought," Cius said. "It was the village of the VC."

The Viet Cong. A group of guerrilla fighters that aided the North Vietnamese Army and other communist forces in South Vietnam. After the aircraft hit the ground, all hell broke loose. "They were not expecting a helicopter to land in the middle of their village, and what happened was everyone was shooting, and getting hit, and hurt," Cius said. "I caught one too." Wounded from the firefight and injured by the crash, Cius somehow avoided capture for a day and a half before his luck ran out.

VC troops captured him on June 5, 1967, sending him to the notorious "Hanoi Hilton" in North Vietnam. Cius's tiny cell and the four walls that enclosed it would be his home for the next 2,100 days before being released on March 5, 1973, during Operation Homecoming.

"It's nice to share what I've been through with other people," Cius told reporters after his speech. Medically retiring from the Marine Corps as a staff sergeant in 1978, Cius received both the Prisoner of War and Bronze Star medals for his acts of valor.

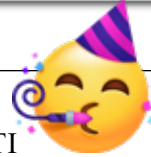

Report: Fiber may prevent breast cancer

Parents and young women concerned about breast cancer may want to take note of a study from the journal *Pediatrics*: Scientists have discovered that adolescents and young women can significantly reduce their chances of getting breast cancer later in life by eating a high-fiber diet early on.

Researchers tracked more than 90,000 women over a period of years. Women 27-44 answered questions relating to their diet as adults and in high school. The data they collected about fiber consumption, after screening out other factors like race and family history of breast cancer, showed that women who had eaten high amounts of fiber had a 12-19 percent lower chance of getting breast cancer. In addition, women who reported a high fiber intake during their high school years were found to have a 16 percent lower risk of suffering breast cancer overall, as well as a 24 percent lower risk of being diagnosed before menopause.

Fiber from fruits and vegetables appear to offer the most health benefits.

Keep your workplace a healthy zone

From Ebola to the Zika virus, new diseases seem to be rising every day to threaten our health. If you're a manager, you should do everything you can to keep your workforce safe from illness. Take these steps to minimize the risks:

- **Adjust absentee policies.** Many organizations still penalize workers for taking sick leave. Let your employees stay home when they're sick rather than risk infecting others.
- **Promote hygiene.** Post restroom signs urging workers to wash their hands frequently. Instruct cleaning services to wipe down telephone receivers as well as desk surfaces.
- **Plan ahead.** Consider how you'd respond if your department experienced a 30 percent absentee rate. How can you ensure that essential functions are covered? You can't stop bad things from happening, but you can take steps to keep them from crippling your organization.
