PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Our 2025 team of Board of Directors closed out the year having worked diligently on many fronts. Jan and I are very happy to see all Directors who chose to re-run, were re-elected for an additional term. We had one new board member join us, Maggie Stokes, replacing David Bell. Dave, thank you for your support!

Jan McCoy has served as board president for the last three years, making contributions to the community too numerous to mention and guiding us through a very rough year of multiple hurricanes. We are now in much better shape to weather future storms.

The Walmart gate project will soon be complete. Final wiring to establish Duke Energy connectivity is taking place shortly. Requests for final quotes for the lift station redesign are in process. Engineering work is taking place for the watermain redesign. Window replacement on the back side of the shuffleboard court has been lagging. Are you wondering why? We were too. It turns out the vendor who manufactures the windows moved their entire manufacturing facility and was very behind with their orders. That being said, our windows have now been constructed and installation can be scheduled. The installation of the back generator at the lake is complete and has passed inspection. The front generator is pending final inspection with the installation of the transfer switch now complete. Vendor quotes are being sourced by our Infrastructure Committee to address the broken cement walkway. They should soon be presented for approval by the Board.

We are currently working on transition of roles and responsibilities and creating a new committee structure for 2026. Thank you to residents who are choosing to continue to volunteer their time on the various chosen focuses for the coming year. Our efforts will focus on the efficiency of park management, rules and by-laws update, maintaining the value of our assets/common elements with on-going infrastructure projects and ultimately providing an improved quality of life for the entire association. We are fortunate to have as many activities as we do, and we look forward to adding recreational amenities that will provide even more opportunities to remain active healthy retirees as requested by our community members.

Watch for announcements from the Vision Committee who will be hosting additional informational sessions for a presentation of preliminary plans for the addition of a multi-use outdoor sports area with bathroom facility. These plans are in their early brainstorming development phase by the volunteer Sports & Recreational Focus Group led by Drew Lawrence. The time is now if you wish to be informed up front and offer input to the development of these important amenities.






