





All outside additions or renovations to your home, including outside painting of any type, room additions, utility rooms or extensions, cement work, ramps, pavers, gravel, ect., must be approved by the Board of Directors and a permit obtained from the office at least 5 business days in advance before starting work. A sketch of the work plan and paint color must accompany the request.

- 2. All required City permits are the responsibility of the Resident.
- 3. The permit must be displayed in a clearly visible area.
- 4. All work must be complete within terms of the written approval/improvement permit.





- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- ☐ Whistle to signal for help
- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- ☐ Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps



Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- ☐ Prescription medications and glasses
- ☐ Infant formula and diapers
- ☐ Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- ☐ Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- ☐ Cash and change
- ☐ Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- ☐ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.







- Federal Recognition: It became a federal holiday in 1894, following the Pullman Strike—a nationwide railroad strike that led to significant unrest and prompted President Grover Cleveland to make peace with the labor movement.


