





10 FUN FACTS ABOUT DUNEDIN

unedin has some truly **quirky and unusual** facts that make it stand out from other Florida towns. Here are a few you might not know:

1. A Secret 1920s Speakeasy 🏂

Dunedin is home to a hidden gem with some serious Prohibition-era charm—the Flamingo Lounge. While it may seem like a regular bar today, it's said to have been a speakeasy during the Prohibition era when alcohol was illegal. Some locals still speculate that the place hides remnants of its secret past!

2. Dunedin is the "Cycling Capital" of Florida 🚴

It's not just the Pinellas Trail that makes Dunedin bike-friendly. The town has been recognized as one of Florida's Best Bike-Friendly Cities due to its vast network of biking paths, scenic routes, and bike racks everywhere. It's even home to one of the oldest bicycle shops in Florida, The Bicycle Shop, which has been serving the community for over 50 years!

3. Scottish Roots

Dunedin was originally called "Pennekamp," but it was later renamed to reflect its Scottish heritage. The name "Dunedin" comes from the Scottish Gaelic name for Edinburgh, the capital of Scotland. You'll even find a Scottish-American Society here and a Dunedin Highland Games every year.

4. Dunedin's Underground History

Did you know there's a hidden underground chamber in Dunedin? It's part of a mystery surrounding the Dunedin Bottle House, which is rumored to be linked to an old underground network used during Prohibition for hiding illegal booze. While some details remain vague, the idea of secret tunnels under Dunedin has made it a subject of local folklore.

5. The Haunted Historic District 👻

Dunedin is rumored to have some of the spookiest spots in Florida, especially in its historic district. From ghostly apparitions to mysterious sounds, places like the Pioneer Park and The Fenway Hotel have long been a part of local ghost lore. Some say the hotel, which dates back to the 1920s, is haunted by former guests—with reports of strange noises, flickering lights, and ghostly sightings.

6. A Town With a "Cat" and "Dog" Park 🛙 😼

Dunedin has two unique animal parks: The "Doggie Park", and its lesser-known but equally interesting neighbor, the "Cat Park"! Yes, there's a small, unofficial space in town dedicated to stray cats where they can hang out and roam freely, with locals keeping it stocked with food and water for the feline visitors. Dunedin's commitment to its animals is legendary, but this one's definitely offbeat!

7. Dunedin's Own Microclimate

Dunedin enjoys a bit of a microclimate compared to other areas in Florida. It tends to be slightly cooler and less humid, especially during the hot summer months, making it a bit of a hidden gem for those looking to escape the heat.

8. A Hotspot for Craft Breweries

Dunedin has quickly become a craft beer lover's dream! The town is home to several award-winning breweries like Dunedin Brewery, Florida's oldest craft brewery. It's also where you can find the 3 Daughters Brewing taproom!

9. Dunedin's Historic Homes

The city is home to many historic homes that date back to the early 20th century, including charming bungalows and Mediterranean Revival-style homes. Many of these homes are nestled along the waterfront, offering stunning views of the Gulf of Mexico.

10. The World's Largest Collection of Tiki Mugs 🗳

If you're a fan of tiki culture, Dunedin is home to one of the largest tiki mug collections in the world, displayed at the Tiki Cove Restaurant. There, you can find a treasure trove of vintage mugs, many of which are rare or no longer in production. Tiki lovers and collectors from around the globe stop by to admire the extensive display!

So, Dunedin is definitely not your average Florida town! With its hidden histories, quirky spots, and fun surprises, it's a place that's both charming and full of surprises!






Identity Theft Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- · Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- · Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- · Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- · Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- · Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are someone in authority. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- · IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- · Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- · Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- · Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- · Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with vour account.




