




LABOR DAY:

bserved on the first Monday in September, Labor Day is an annual celebration of the social and economic achievements of American workers. The holiday is rooted in the late nineteenth century, when labor activists pushed for a federal holiday to recognize the many contribution workers have made to America's strength, prosperity and well-being.

Before it was a federal holiday, Labor Day was recognized by labor activists and individual states. After municipal ordinances were passed in 1885 and 1886, a movement developed to secure state legislation. New York was the first state to introduce a bill, but Oregon was the first to pass a law recognizing Labor Day, on February 21, 1887. During 1887, four more states – Colorado, Massachusetts, New Jersey and New York – passed laws creating a Labor Day holiday. By the end of the decade Connecticut, Nebraska and Pennsylvania had followed suit. By 1894, 23 more states had adopted the holiday, and on June 28, 1894, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September of each year a legal holiday".

- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- ☐ Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps

- ☐ Mess kits, Paper cups, plates and disposable utensils, paper
- ☐ Paper and pencil Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

SEPTEMBER WEATHER STAY ALERT:

eptember is often considered the worst month for hurricanes in Florida because it's the most likely month for landfall hurricanes. The peak of hurricane season is September 10, with most activity occurring between mid-August and mid-October. This is because ocean waters take longer to heat up than air and retain heat longer, creating more favorable conditions for tropical cyclones.

If you hear talk of Hurricanes, Tropical Storms, or Storm Surges, pay attention. Follow any guidelines that are always talked about on Spectrum Bay News channel 9, or on the Spectrum Weather channel which is channel 63. There is also information in the Clubhouse for you to pick up and familiarize yourself with, the evacuation routes, etc. There have been articles in other Scuttlebutt issues with information as to what to pack in your TO-GO-BOX, should you have to evacuate, sites for assistance, and contact information.

HURRICANE PREPARATION

Por residents of Seminole who reside in a mobile home park, the majority of owners are aged 55 and older. Hurricane season is designated from June through November. Most important among the ideas is a to-go-bag containing: important papers/documents in a watertight container, make sure meds are enough to cover one week beyond evacuation, pack clothing and food supplies, have cash on hand and arrange for your own transport via Pinellas County, neighbor, own car with a full tank of gas, or friends nearby.

Instructions on evacuation routes, bus lines to use and notification to relatives where evacuees' destination is are critical. We instruct everyone to place possible "flying objects" inside, close all doors and windows and disable utilities if possible when **warning** occurs. Pets require attention and supplies as well. If **ALL CLEAR** is given, upon return, assess damages and contact local FEMA organization and your insurance carrier with pictures to verify any damage. A directory of important numbers will be available to households along with the Pinellas County Emergency Mgmt. newspaper publication prior to hurricane season.

1 Tablespoon apple cider vinegar


1 Teaspoons honey


