



Lan't believe how quickly the summer is coming to an end. The board has been busy this summer with the transition to Qualified Property Management. New signs have been posted around the community with their contact information.



Your first monthly maintenance fee with QPM was processed on August 4th. If your payment did not come out of your account, please contact the office to discuss.

The Unity of Title (combining the Hardin lot with 1040 Main Street) is complete. Our attorney has made application to the city and county for a zoning and land use change for that parcel with the anticipated completion of this application and approval during late fall. Stay tuned for more information on this subject.

With the fall approaching, we want to remind members who rent out their units, to please make a copy of our rules available to your tenants. All paperwork for tenants must be completed by the homeowner and submitted to the office for approval PRIOR to their arrival.







- Quit smoking, or don't start. Get free help at smokefree.gov, 1-800-QUIT-NOW (1-800-784-8669), or text QUIT to 47848.
- Avoid secondhand tobacco smoke. Stay away from places where smoking is allowed. Ask any friends and family members who smoke to do it outside.
- Be physically active. Physical activity can help strengthen your heart and lungs, so they work better. Talk to your doctor about what level of physical activity is right for you.
- Limit exposure to air pollution. Check the Air Quality Index (airnow.gov) before outdoor activities. Make sure your home is aired out and cleaned regularly.
- Stay up to date on vaccines against diseases that harm the lungs. These can include flu, COVID-19, and pneumonia.
- Use protective gear if your work exposes you to dust, silica, allergens, chemical fumes, or other pollution sources.
- Make good sleep a priority. Poor sleep can cause lung disease symptoms to worsen. Sleep is also critical to overall health.

Medicare Scams

HOW IT WORKS

- You get unexpected and urgent communications from someone claiming to be from Medicare.
- They may say you need a new card or that your birth date doesn't match their records.
- They may warn that you're about to lose benefits if you don't act immediately.

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Criminals often use caller ID spoofing to make a call appear as if it's coming from Medicare or another trusted source.
- They may sound legitimate and even reference some of your personal details, but their goal is to steal your personal information or your money.
- Medicare will not call you unless you first receive a letter that you will be contacted or if you called and left a message.
- Medicare does not issue plastic cards or call to offer new ones.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

- The only people who you can safely share Medicare information with are your health providers.
- If you're concerned there might be a problem, contact Medicare directly at Medicare.gov or 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227).
- You can also reach out to the Senior Medicare Patrol in your area to report Medicare fraud or abuse and to seek assistance.





Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are someone in authority. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- · Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- · Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- · Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- · Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with vour account.

How to report identity theft

Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

· Bills for items you did not buy

· Denials of loan applications

• Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open

· Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

· Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- · Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- · Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- · Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- · Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.




