

apital Expenditure Updates for 2025

-Canal Seawall is nearing completion in Park 1. The next priority will be the seawall behind Lots 411-413 in Park 3. Park Management is still trying to reach out to the property owner on the business side of the canal to get agreement on the initiation of the work.

- Sidewalk repair work for 2025 has been completed. Residents and the members of the board have made Park Management aware that there are several areas in the park that were missed during this round of repairs. We will continue to press to determine if any additional work can be done this year or we will make this a priority for 2026.
- Park 1 Pool Heater work has not started and is pending a review of bids by Park Management.

There will be no other capital expenditure projects funded by the Park Owners in 2025.

Capital Expenditure Priorities for 2026 (first thoughts)

- Sidewalk repair Phase II
- Canal seawall Phase II
- Park 2 pool deck / tile repair, pool pit replacement
- Mailbox post replacement
- Leak detection service
- Park 3 fountain repair/restoration/replacement

We need **YOUR** input on the request for capital expenditure projects! Please join a future Park Association or HOA meeting to have your voice heard. You can also contact any member of the board to add items to this list.

Pool Pass Wristband pilot. The HOA is going to work with Park 2 Association Board on piloting the use and distribution of Pool Pass Wristbands to Park 2 residents. As many of you are aware, this is an attempt to prevent non-residents from using the amenities. This has been a problem in Park 2 this summer.








Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- · Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- · Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- · Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- · Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- · Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are someone in authority. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- · IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- · Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- · Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- · Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- · Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with vour account.

The Early Bird Shuffle

In Port Charlotte, a local diner owner shared how snowbirds would start lining up at 4:30 p.m. for the early bird special. "It's like clockwork," he said. "They come in, order the fish fry, and are out before sunset. One couple even brought their own salt shaker because they said ours wasn't 'zesty enough.'"




