
### **GHA Homeowners Association of Pinellas County, Inc.**

<u>"American Dirt"</u> by Jeanine Cummins: gripping fiction of the migrant trail from one corner of the globe. She provides 2017 estimates that 200 migrants die seeking refuge every 90 minutes around the world. - KELLY WILLIAMS

<u>Deep Blue</u> by Randy Wayne White. Another in the series of thrillers about Doc Ford and his two lives, this book has all the ingredients to fascinate you and stir your curiosity. Lots of action - on land and in the ocean. Keeps the book moving at a good pace. There are several surprises and of course, a great ending. All in all, I thought it a terrific read. 

Roadrunner email addresses with the tampabay.rr.com domain are being discontinued by Spectrum. This means you can no longer send or receive emails using that address.

Spectrum recommends switching to a free webmail service like Gmail, Yahoo Mail, or Outlook.com.

Here's a more detailed explanation:

Discontinuation: Spectrum, which owns Roadrunner, has been phasing out the Roadrunner email platform since 2012, and as of October 2023, tampabay.rr.com email addresses are no longer functional.

No New Accounts: You can no longer create new Roadrunner email accounts.

Active Accounts: While existing users can still access their Roadrunner emails, the tampabay. rr.com domain is being discontinued, meaning that emails using that domain will not be delivered.

Alternative: To continue using email, you will need to switch to a new email provider.

Legacy Login: If you are trying to access your Roadrunner email through the legacy login, it's important to use the correct settings, including the password for the legacy login, which may differ from your Spectrum.net password.

Server Settings: When setting up a new email account, you may need to use specific server settings. For example, you might need to use mail.twc.com as the IMAP server, according to the email toolbox.

I was personally made aware of this issue during July when, without notice, I suddenly lost access to my four working tampabay.rr email accounts. I suspect it was the result of my having cancelled my Spectrum service and not shown interest in what they believed to be the affordably discounted service value were I to re-subscribe. 
