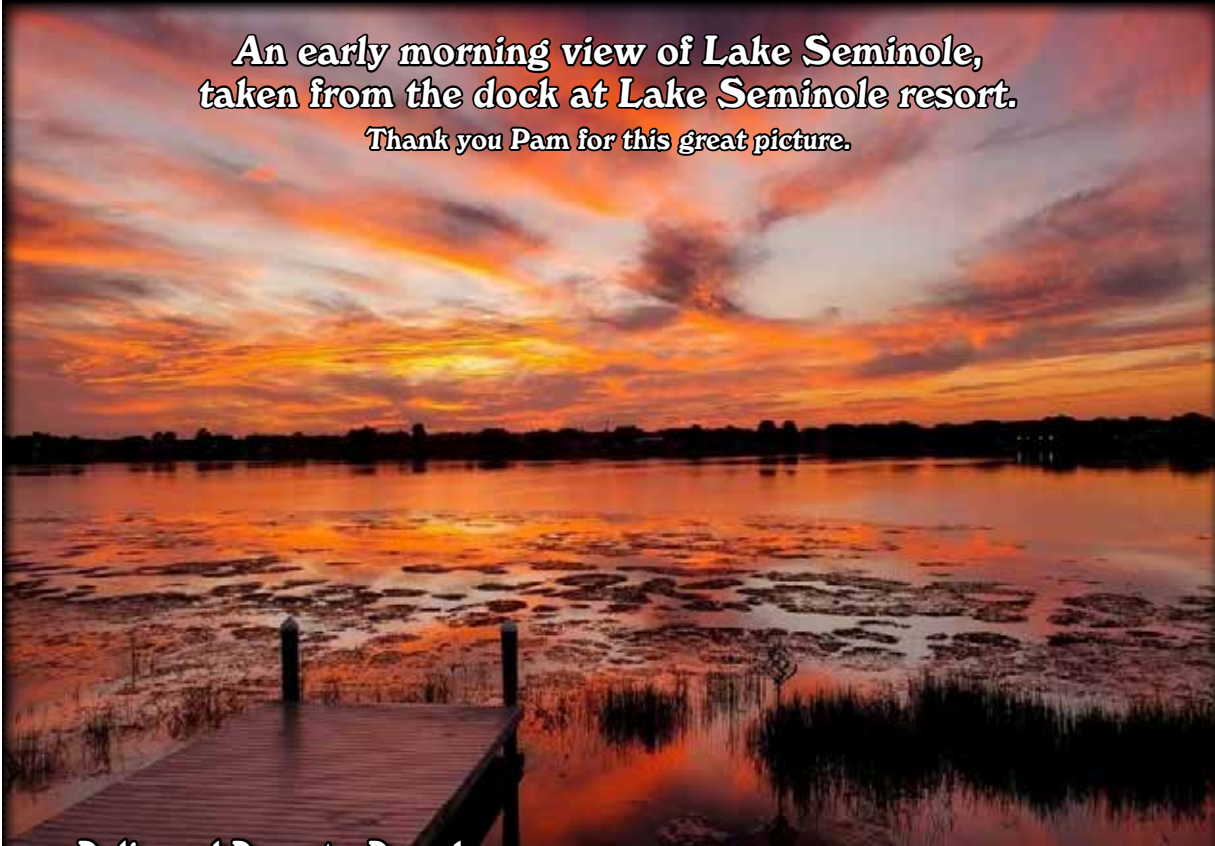

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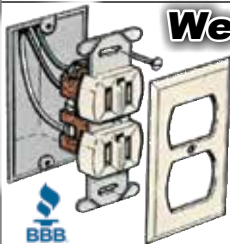

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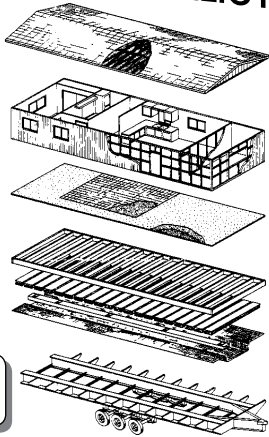
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SOCIAL CLUB ELECTIONS

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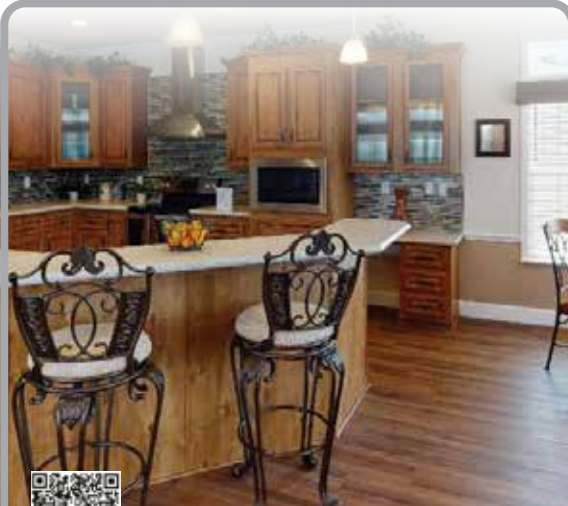
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SENIOR EMPOWERMENT

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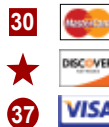
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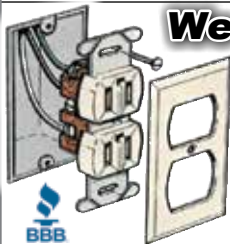

LEMON SQUARES (Neiman-Marcus)

1 c. flour	1/2 c. butter	1/4 c. powdered sugar
2 eggs	3/4 c. sugar	3 Tbsp. lemon juice
2 Tbsp. flour	1/2 tsp. baking powder	

Blend flour, butter, and powdered sugar until mixture resembles meal. Pat mixture into 8-inch square baking pan. Bake in 350 oven for 12 - 15 min. or until pale golden. In another bowl, beat 2 eggs until light and lemon colored, mix in sugar and lemon juice and beat mixture for 8 min. Blend in flour and baking powder. Pour mixture over baked layer and bake in 350 oven for 20 min. Sift powdered sugar over top and let it cool. Cut into 2-inch squares. Makes 16.





SHRIMP AND SCALLOPS ON SPAGHETTI

| 1/2 lb. small shrimp, shelled and deveined | 1/2 lb. bay scallops |
| 3 cloves garlic, minced | 1/2 c. chopped celery |
| 1/4 c. green pepper, chopped | 1/4 c. mushrooms |
| 1/2 stick butter | 1/2 lb. mozzarella cheese, sliced |
| 1 chicken bouillon cube | 1 c. water |
| 1/4 lb. spaghetti | |



Melt butter in 10-inch skillet. Add garlic, celery, pepper, and mushrooms and cook till tender. Add shrimp and scallops. Heat, stirring, until just cooked. Add water and bouillon cube and heat. Set aside, keeping warm. Cook spaghetti till tender. Spoon 2 Tbsp. liquid from shrimp/scallop mixture into each of 6 individual oven-proof serving casseroles. Place 10 - 15 strands spaghetti in liquid. Divide scallop-shrimp mixture among casseroles, spooning over spaghetti. Top with 3 thin slices of cheese. Bake at 350 for 10 - 15 min. or until lightly browned. Sprinkle 1/4 tsp parsley over cheese. Serve with salad and bread sticks. Serves 6.
