






### PREPARING FOR THE ANNUAL MEETING

Belection. IF you did not receive your notice, please contact Ameri-Tech immediately. It may be that the address on file is not updated. The deadline to submit the Notice of Intent to be a Candidate for the Board was October 22, 2025. Four current members of the Board; Gene Arend, Bob Barr, Al Hartin and Pat Rivera are completing their current term. At this time, they can submit to run for re-election for the 2026-2027 term. Also, anyone who has submitted a qualifying nomination will be listed on the ballot. This will have been announced by the time you read this. The election will be conducted Monday, December 1, 2025, at the Clubhouse at the beginning of the Annual Meeting.

The ballots will be mailed with the Second Notice of the Annual Meeting. The election will conclude before the business of the Annual Meeting is conducted and those elected will be seated after the Annual Meeting.

IF you cannot attend the Annual Meeting, you can sign your proxy form (which was included in the Second Notice of Meeting) and give this form to myself, Connie Holmes or Ray Jablonski to verify we meet the required minimum number of proxies (159) to hold the meeting. You can even turn it in early (and we hope you do) AND still attend in person. The



top line can be left blank (no name filled in); you are allowing the President (or whoever you list) to vote in your behalf. The Proxy form will have questions at the bottom for you to vote on. Please fill this part out before giving the form to be counted.

You will be voting on the Reserves; whether to fully fund or to partially fund. At the October Board meeting, Al Hartin, treasurer, discussed the proposed budget line-by-line explaining the reasoning. You will receive a Budget breakdown and explanation of the Budget with your Second Notice of Annual Meeting. The Directors voted at the October Board meeting to recommend partial funding with a monthly fee of \$235.00.

If you have further questions, please contact a Board member. We CANNOT tell you how to vote on any item, but we can explain or clarify any questions you might have.

### **BOARD NOMINATION**

would like to clarify the Article in the October Media titled "NEW DIRECTORS NEEDED ON THE CONDO BOARD". The article quoted the new Florida Law regarding Board Member term limitations. While most of what is written is correct it states incorrectly that if I was elected that I would have to vacate my position on July 1, 2026. This is incorrect and I have quoted below an attorney's explanation of the new law.

"Per legislation passed in 2021 condo boards in Florida have a term limit of 8 years. It applies to board members elected to terms starting in July 2018 or after". Based on this if reelected I would serve the full two-year term.

I have submitted my nomination for a Board of Director position on the Briar Creek MHP Phase#1 Board. I am currently on the Board serving as the Treasurer. I believe that I can continue to contribute to ensure that Briar Creek Phase 1 remains fiscally sound while also maintaining our amenities and infrastructure and am asking for your support to continue serving as a Director. Thank You.

# What's Up With Pickleball??

The have several residents in both Phases I and II who play pickleball and I am often asked what is happening given the explosive interest and growth in the sport. As we look forward to completion of our court in Phase II in the not too distant future, I hope you don't mind my updates on what is happening in the sport outside of BC.

First The Guinness Book of World Records just announced that Joyce Jones from Washington State, at the spritely young age of 95, was just recognized as the oldest competing pickleball



female player in the world. She recently won the Gold Medal at the Huntsman World Senior Games in St. George, Utah. Her goal is to be the first to receive the honor at age 100.

As of 2025, 60 countries are now members of the International Federation of Pickleball. There are now over 50 million players worldwide including nearly 20 million players in the US. The US currently leads in the number of courts available with over 68,000 across the country and upwards of 1,000 new courts being constructed each month. 18,000 new courts were constructed in the US alone in 2024. Over 8,000 tennis courts have been converted to pickleball courts with Florida and California leading the growth. Naples, Florida is known as the Pickleball Capital of the World. In 2025, Margaritaville sponsored the Open Championships at the Naple's Pickleball Center with 3400 players from 30 countries and all 50 states.

What do seniors say is the main reasons for playing pickleball? They constantly talk about the fun meeting people, the social nature of the sport and the health benefits that contribute to a better quality of life as we age. As for me? Pickleball helps me justify eating pizza and drinking beer.
