




- Be prepared to evacuate. **HAVE A PLAN!** Know how and what to secure if a hurricane threatens.
- Sign up for the **Alert Pinellas**, it's a free emergency notification service, online at www.pinellascounty.org/alertpinellas. This service provides multiple ways to notify you, such as landlines, mobile phones, email, and text messages, whenever an urgent situation such as flooding, arises in your location.
- There is also an application for your smartphone "Ready Pinellas."
- It doesn't hurt to check your homeowner's policy for coverage.
- If a tornado warning is issued you would be better off going to the clubhouse or pavilion bathrooms (be sure you have the codes written down) than staying in your mobile home, park model or RV.
- Please stay safe, Have a great summer!

There is LCR (a dice game) on Monday evenings and Bingo on Wednesday evenings, both begin at 7:00pm (Bring your quarters!!). Dog Poop

The complaints continue about people not cleaning up after their animals and not walking them in the pet area. Pet areas are marked on the map. Please take your "doggie bag" home with you or deposit them in the dumpster at the compactor, do not deposit them in the trash cans at the laundry facility or in activity areas.

Also, all the sports enthusiasts would appreciate it if you did not allow your pets to defecate in the pits that we use for Volleyball, Horseshoes and Petanque.

A reminder that pets are not allowed to go onto other people's lots unless they have permission to do so. This is in the park rules.

Your Options:

You can let your pet go in your own yard before walking it.

You can walk your pet to the pet-walking areas.

You can let your pet go on the road. Yes, they pull to go into people's yard's but you are in control of your pet, you pet does not control you.

Pets must be on a leash no longer than six feet. Retractable leashes extend many feet, often blocking the whole road. This is also in the park rules.

Some people get upset at pets doing their business in their yards. Not everyone loves your pet, so please obey the rules, and be sure to pick up after your pet.



If you are making any changes or additions to your home site or the exterior of your home, please come to the office and submit a completed request (green sheet). Paint colors must be approved, and a request form must be approved. Submit your written request and wait until you have received approval before proceeding with any work. Anyone other than the homeowner working on the home must be licensed and insured and we must have a copy of such on file in the office.


