

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

ditor's Note: We all enjoy our Thanksgiving meal, but the leftovers can sometimes overwhelm us (and our refrigerator!). Here are two recipes for the leftovers.

LEFTOVER TURKEY POT PIE

Ingredients:

1 cup frozen peas and carrots
1 cup frozen green beans
1/2 cup sliced celery
2 1/2 Tbsp butter
1/3 cup diced onion
1/3 cup all purpose flour

1/2 teaspoon salt1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper

1/4 teaspoon celery seed
1/4 teaspoon onion powder
1/4 teaspoon Italian seasoning
7 oz chicken broth

2/3 cup milk 2 cups cubed leftover cooked turkey

1 14-oz package pastry for 9-inch double crust pie

Directions:

Step 1: Preheat oven to 425°.

STEP 2: Place frozen peas, carrots, and beans in a saucepan with celery; add enough water to cover and bring to a boil. Reduce heat to mediumlow and simmer until celery is tender, about 8 minutes. Drain.

STEP 3: While vegetables are simmering, melt butter in a saucepan over medium heat. Add onion and cook until translucent, about 5 minutes. Add flour, salt, pepper, celery seed, onion powder, and Italian seasoning and whisk until a paste is formed, about 1 minute.

STEP 4: Slowly whisk in chicken broth and then milk until incorporated; bring to a simmer and cook, whisking constantly, until sauce thickens, 3 to 5 minutes.

STEP 5: Remove thickened sauce from the heat; add cooked, drained vegetables and cubed turkey, and stir until filling is well combined.

STEP 6: Fit pie pastry into the bottom of 9-inch pie dish. Spoon filling into the dish, then lay remaining pastry over the top. Pinch and roll the top and bottom pastries together at the edges to seal. Use a sharp knife to cut several small slits in pastry top to allow steam to escape while cooking. Place pie plate on a baking sheet.

STEP7: Bake in preheated oven for 15 minutes. Check the top crust for browning; if browning too quickly, cover with aluminum foil. Continue to bake until the crust is golden brown and the filling is bubbly, 15 to 20 more minutes.

STEP 8: Let pie cool for 10 minutes before serving.

Ingredients:

3 cups chopped cooked turkey

1/2 cup dried cranberries

1/2 cup sliced almonds (optional)

2 stalks celery, chopped

2 tablespoons mayonnaise

Directions:

STEP 1: Place turkey and mayonnaise in a bowl; stir until turkey is evenly coated.

STEP 2: Add cranberries, almonds (optional), and celery. Mix until well blended.

STEP 3: Chill before serving.



Definition of an appointment: When two (2) people agree on a time and place to meet.
