

FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Rules, Regulations and Policies Summary — Which Comes First?

he Rules and Policies come last—they must follow (and cannot override) the Declaration, Articles, and Bylaws.
for Florida HOAs, since "rules" and "policies" are often used interchangeably but have different legal and practical meanings.

Here's the breakdown

1. Rules

Definition:

Rules are specific, enforceable standards of conduct established by the HOA Board to regulate the day-to-day use of property and common areas.

Purpose:

To interpret or carry out the restrictions already in the Declaration of Covenants (CC&Rs).

Examples:

- "No parking on the street overnight."
- "Pool hours are 8 AM 10 PM."
- "Garbage bins must be stored out of sight by 8 PM on collection day."

Key Features:

- Enforceable through fines or suspensions (per Florida Statute §720.305).
- Must not conflict with the Declaration, Articles, or Bylaws.
- Require proper notice and opportunity for members to comment before adoption (Florida Statute §720.303(2)(c)).
- Typically affect all residents or common property use.

2. Policies

Definition:

Policies are internal guidelines or administrative procedures adopted by the Board to clarify how the HOA operates or enforces its governing documents.

Purpose:

To ensure consistency and fairness in board actions or management decisions.

Examples:

- "Policy on how violation letters are issued."
- "Policy for architectural review submissions and response time."
- "Policy on handling payment plans for delinquent assessments."

Key Features:

- Usually not directly enforceable against owners like rules are.
- Serve as management tools to guide board and staff actions.
- Can help demonstrate the HOA is acting consistently and reasonably if challenged legally.

Simple way to remember:

Rules tell residents what they can or can't do.

Policies tell the board and manager how to handle things.

Here's a sample structure that many well-run Florida HOAs use to clearly separate Rules (for residents) and Policies (for board and management).

This kind of format helps keep everything organized, compliant with Florida Statute Chapter 720, and easy for homeowners to understand.

Part A — Rules and Regulations

These are enforceable standards for residents and guests.

- 1. Property Appearance and Maintenance
 - Lawn care and landscaping standards
 - Exterior paint and roof maintenance
 - Trash and recycling storage
 - · Seasonal decorations

2. Parking and Vehicles

- Number and location of vehicles allowed
- Street and guest parking restrictions
- Commercial and recreational vehicle storage
- Towing policy reference

- 3. Pets and Animals
 - Number and type of pets allowed
 - Leash requirements and noise control
 - Pet waste disposal rules
- 4. Use of Common Areas
 - Pool, clubhouse, gym, and park rules
 - Hours of operation
 - Guest policies and conduct expectations
- 5. Architectural Control
 - Process for exterior modifications
 - Approved paint colors, fencing, roofing
 - Landscaping changes and tree removal
- 6. Leasing and Occupancy
 - Lease approval process (if applicable)
 - Minimum lease term requirements
 - Owner responsibility for tenant compliance

Part B —

Board and Administrative Policies

These guide how the HOA operates — not direct homeowner behavior.

- 1. Enforcement Policy
 - Step-by-step process for rule violations
 - Notice, hearing, and fine procedures
 - Appeals process
- 2. Collection Policy
 - Assessment due dates
 - · Late fees and interest
 - Payment plan and lien process

- 3. Architectural Review Policy
 - Application submission procedures
 - Review timelines and documentation
 - Reconsideration or appeal process
- 4. Communication Policy
 - Board meeting notices
 - Owner information requests and records access
 - HOA website or bulletin board postings
- 5. Financial and Budget Policy
 - Budget preparation and approval
 - Reserve fund use
 - Annual audit or review requirements
- 6. Vendor and Contract Policy
 - · Bidding process
 - Conflict-of-interest rules
 - Insurance and performance expectations

Tips for Clarity and Compliance

- Keep Rules resident-focused and brief (2–4 pages max).
- Keep Policies procedural and detailed (for board use).
- Adopt Rules only after proper notice to members (per §720.303(2)(c)).
- Policies may be adopted by board resolution at an open meeting.
- Review annually to ensure consistency with updated Florida laws.



American Thanksgiving History

Early Thanksgivings

• Virginia:

The first documented Thanksgiving service by Europeans in North America was in 1619 at Berkeley Hundred, Virginia, when English settlers arrived and celebrated a religious holiday of thanksgiving.

• Plymouth and Wampanoag:

In 1621, English Pilgrims and Wampanoag people shared a harvest feast in Plymouth, Massachusetts. This event is the historical basis for the American holiday and included deer, corn, and seafood.

• Drought:

The Pilgrims held another Thanksgiving in 1623 to give thanks for rain that ended a drought.

A National Holiday

• George Washington:

In 1789, President George Washington decreed a day of public thanksgiving, establishing a precedent for national observances.

• Abraham Lincoln:

President Abraham Lincoln issued a proclamation in 1863, establishing the last Thursday in November as a national Thanksgiving Day. This marked the beginning of the modern national holiday.

• A Shorter Holiday:

In 1939, due to a shorter Christmas shopping season, President Franklin D. Roosevelt moved Thanksgiving to the penultimate Thursday of November.

• Final Legislation:

After a two-year period with states observing Thanksgiving on different dates, Congress passed a law in 1941 that set the holiday permanently as the fourth Thursday of November.




