

Trash Compound Hours & Disposal Guidelines – Please Read Carefully To help maintain a clean and safe environment for everyone, please follow the updated hours and disposal rules for the trash compound:

Operating Hours:

- Tuesdays: 8:00 AM 3:00 PM
- Fridays: 8:00 AM 3:00 PM
- Saturdays: 8:00 AM 11:00 AM What You Can Dispose Of
- Bagged household trash only is allowed in the enclosed compactor.
- Unbagged items no larger than a standard trash can may be placed in the
- open-top containers.

Prohibited Items

You may not dispose of the following at any time:

- Large furniture
- Construction debris
- Paint, oil, or chemicals
- Electronics
- Tires

Violations of these rules may result in a \$500 fine. Improper disposal creates safety hazards and can lead to serious consequences for the entire community. If you're unsure about an item, please contact the office before bringing it to the compound. Thank you for helping us keep the community clean and compliant!

Please Do Not Feed Stray Cats or Wildlife - It's Prohibited

Feeding stray cats or wildlife may seem like a kind gesture, but in our community, it is strictly prohibited—and for good reason.

Why It's Not Allowed

Feeding stray animals can attract more wildlife, feral cats, and rats which can attract snakes leading to overpopulation, property damage, and health risks. It also disrupts local ecosystems and can increase the spread of diseases like toxoplasmosis, which affects both wildlife and humans. [myfwc.com]

It's Against the Rules—and the Law

While Florida does not have a statewide ban on feeding stray cats, local ordinances and community rules—including those in Pinellas County—prohibit feeding stray animals on private property without permission and near parks, schools, or conservation areas. Violating these rules can result in a formal violation and a \$500 fine. [pinellas.gov]

! What You Can Do Instead

If you're concerned about stray cats or wildlife in the area, please contact the office or local animal services. Programs like Trap-Neuter-Vaccinate-Return (TNVR) exist to humanely manage feral cat populations without encouraging uncontrolled feeding.





INFORMATION ABOUT WATER:

Tasteful and Unnecessary Use of Water Is Prohibited!
These are the basic rules from the Pinellas County website:
Examples of wasteful water usage:

Allowing water to flow from an unattended hose.

Hand-watering a lawn on a restricted day or more than once a day.

Hosing down a driveway or solid surface or structure when a dry method could be used.

Allowing water to flow from a broken sprinkler head or outdoor faucet and having malfunctioning plumbing/-irrigation system after receiving verbal or written notice.

Violations

The Year-Round Conservation Measures and Seasonal Reclaimed Water Restrictions allow the first violation of these restrictions to be issued as a "warning" Notice of Violation. In accordance with Sixth Judicial Circuit Administrative Order No. 2018-068 PI-CTY, Local Ordinance Violations, and Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Violations Uniform Fine Schedule, Attachment A, Miscellaneous Ordinance, Marine Patrol, Fish, and Wildlife Conservation Commission, and Natural Resources Violation fines start at \$193, and may be doubled for a second offense; and for each subsequent offense thereafter. Contested citations may result in the cost of a fine plus additional court costs. For more information after receiving a citation, please contact Business & Customer Services at (727)464-4000.

Protect Your Hot Water Heater During a Water Outage

During an extended water outage, you may want to turn off the water heater by going to the electrical panel and throwing the water heater breaker to the "Off" position. Once the water has been restored, residents should turn the hot water on at a few faucets and make sure that all of the air is out of the lines. Once there is no sputtering and the water is running smoothly, the breaker can be switched back on. This process is to keep the water heater elements from overheating and burning out if the water level gets too low.

Ducks/Wildlife

Please do not feed or put out feeders accessible to ducks or other wildlife. It is illegal in the state of Florida and you could be charged a \$100 fine for each infraction, and it is a violation of the park. Not only that, but if you put out food for the ducks, anything will eat it--stray cats, rats, snakes, and opossums--to name a few. So please don't do it. Thank you!

Smoking and Drinking at the Pool

There is a designated smoking area at the pool and if you smoke, you will be required to smoke there and only there. Also, cigar smoking is offensive to most people and is strictly prohibited at the pool. Violators will lose their privileges to the pool, and if that doesn't



work, we will make the pool completely non-smoking. Every week, the pool company finds butts in the filters. clogging them up and leading to downtime on the pumps which means the pool is closed until repairs are made.

Also, per the health department and code enforcement, drinking alcohol at a public pool is strictly prohibited. NO GLASS OR CANS OF ALCOHOL ARE PERMITTED. The health department will shut down the pool and if we find bottles in the trash we will be forced to shut down the pool as well.

The bottom line is that this is a community which means that the amenities are for everyone. Please be considerate of your neighbors and follow these simple rules so that everyone can enjoy a day by the pool. Thank you.

Do You Want To Be In the Know?

Il announcements, updates or urgent communications from the Management Office to residents are made via our texting system called "Text-Em-All." Pet Policy

People need to pay attention to number THREE.

A few things about pets I want to point out so there are no questions about your responsibility as a pet owner. Keeping a pet on the property is a privilege and not a right and as such, the following rules must be adhered to or we will have no choice but to ask you to remove the animal from the property. These rules apply whether the animal is a household pet, an Emotional Support Animal, or a Service Animal.

- 1. ALL animals must be registered with the office, and we will need all required documentation for any ESA's or Service Animals.
- 2. Dogs are to be on leashes AT ALL TIMES and the handler must maintain control of their animal at all times, not letting it run up or jump on people or other animals.
- 3. PET CATS ARE TO BE INDOOR ANIMALS ONLY.
- 4. You MUST pick up after your pet goes to the bathroom—we do have doggy pots at both properties that have the bags and a container just for that.
- 5. Excessive barking must be controlled so the pet is not bothering the neighbors. I seem to hear this a lot and it is against park rules.

Speeding

here are WAY too many people driving WAY TOO fast in our park. I consider this a SERIOUS NO-NO because we have a LOT of residents riding their bikes or strolling through the neighborhood and many of them use walkers or scooters/wheelchairs and can't move quick enough to avoid an accident. We also have a LOT of beautiful wildlife roaming the park—ducks, turtles, all kinds of birds and the cute little cotton-tail rabbits we see everywhere—and we need to PROTECT them AND our ambulatory residents.. The speed limit is 10 MPH. I think most of our neighbors adhere to this and it is the visitors who are breaking the rules. If you see someone driving too fast, get their license plate number so we can report them to the office. If it is, indeed, a visitor, they can lose the privilege of coming into the park. I think this is VERY important and so should you. Let us all work together to get this problem fixed!

PS—If you think it may be any of your family members or friends (sorry, but it happens), PLEASE tell them to respect YOU by respecting the rules of the place you call home. Also, please let your company know to turn down their RADIOS when within the parameters of the park. Again, they should respect YOU enough to do this. Thank you!

THE CHATBOX

ere is an excerpt from an article I found online titled "Why Do We Eat Turkey on Thanksgiving?" written by John M. Cunningham. It reveals some interesting facts that most of us never knew, so read on, my neighbors and friends!

...nevertheless, turkeys were not yet synonymous with Thanksgiving. Some people have credited <u>Charles Dickens's A Christmas Carol</u> (1843) with <u>bolstering</u> the idea of turkey as a holiday meal. But another writer, <u>Sarah Josepha Hale</u>, played an arguably more important role. In her 1827 novel *Northwood*, she devoted an entire chapter to a description of a New England Thanksgiving, with a roasted turkey "placed at the head of the table." At about the same time, she also began campaigning to establish Thanksgiving as a national holiday in the United States, which she believed would help unify the country as it teetered toward civil war. Her efforts finally paid off in 1863 with a presidential proclamation by <u>Abraham Lincoln</u>.






