

Do you belong to 'Team Coyote'?

In their book, Beep! Beep! Competing in the Age of the Road Runner, Chip R. Bell and Oren Harari discuss the messages we can learn from one of the most recognizable pair of antagonists around: Wile E. Coyote and the Road Runner. The authors describe two different cartoons:

In one, the coyote holds a medicine bottle labeled "Acme Hi-Speed Tonic—Contains vitamins R+P+M." When he gives a spoonful to a small mouse, the rodent zooms around at jet speed. The coyote drinks the whole bottle and zips off after the Road Runner. But the Road Runner stops suddenly, sticks out his foot, and trips Mr. Coyote.

The second cartoon begins with a close shot on a box labeled: "One Acme Jet-Propelled Pogo Stick." Wile E. removes the pogo stick from the box, switches it on, mounts it, and waits for the Road Runner. As the Road Runner races by, Wile E. begins bouncing up and down after him. But soon the coyote loses control of the stick and falls backward over a cliff.

"What these scenes show is that you cannot remain a coyote and expect to compete against road runners by simply copying their movements," write the authors. "Sure, the coyote can buy high-speed tonic or jet-propelled pogo sticks, but his body and soul are still coyote. If you are a coyote team or organization, no matter what fads or quick fixes you jump into, you are just imitating a road runner—and the real thing will beat you every time."

What is a moment really worth?

- To realize the value of a millisecond: Ask the person who has won a silver medal in the Olympics.



In dreams, you can control your reality



The movie *Inception* explored the idea of controlling one's dreams. Although that featured collapsing cities and struggles in zero gravity, the concept of guiding your own dreams isn't so outlandish. "Lucid dreaming" can allow you to fly, conquer nightmares, and solve real-life problems.

Here's how to take control of your nighttime visions:

- **Keep a dream journal.** The first step to controlling dreams is remembering them. Keep a journal close to your bed, and write down any dream you have as soon as you wake up (or keep a digital voice recorder handy). Look for recurring themes—people, situations, etc. This trains your brain to become more aware of dream activity.
- **Do a "dream check."** Throughout the day, pause and ask yourself, "Am I dreaming?" This trains your mind to start asking the same question while you're asleep.
- Nap. Some studies suggest the best time to attempt a lucid dream is during a nap taken a few hours after getting up in the morning. If you wake up during a dream, stay quiet and try to return to the dream as you drift off again.
- **Perform a reality check.** After some practice, you'll start being aware of the fact that you're in a dream. To confirm this, try some experiments: Look at a clock, turn away, then look again. In dreams, the time will change. Or look at yourself in a mirror; in a dream, the image you see will be distorted or blurry.
- Take off! Once you're aware that you're dreaming, try taking charge of the environment. Jump up and down to see if you can fly, for example. If you're having a nightmare, confront the danger instead of running away; this can reduce the fear you feel when you

ere's a simple exercise for your brain: Pick a small number and then double it in your mind—no paper, no calculator. How far can you get?

Take the number 7, for example:

7, 14, 28, 56, 112, 224, 448, 896 . . .

Are you a few years away from a heart attack? Or maybe just a few minutes? No one can tell you for sure, but you can evaluate your risk for suffering a coronary. Just be on the lookout for these health and lifestyle factors that can indicate the likelihood of having a heart attack at some point in your life:

• Age. The older you are, unfortunately, the higher your risk. Men who are 45 or older and women 55 or older are more likely to suffer heart attacks than younger people.

• Gender. Men are more at risk than women, although at older ages women are more likely to die within a few weeks of a heart attack than men are.

- Family history. Heart disease can have a genetic component. If your parents, grandparents, or siblings have suffered heart attacks, your own risk rises. Race may also play a role: Heart disease seems to be more common among African-Americans, Mexican-Americans, Native Americans, and some other ethnic groups.
- Smoking. Cigarettes, cigars, and second-hand smoke can increase your risk of heart attack. Cigarette smoking doubles the threat.
- Cholesterol. High levels of low-density lipoprotein (LDL) raise your risk, as does an excess amount of triglycerides.
- High blood pressure. The harder your heart has to work, the greater your chances of suffering a heart attack, as well as stroke and kidney failure.
- Diabetes. Your body's inability to produce enough insulin to process glucose in your blood can contribute to heart disease.
- Weight issues. Obesity, which is often linked to the three factors listed above, places stress on your heart.
- Lack of physical activity. Regular exercise can alleviate many of the risk factors associated with heart attack, controlling weight, blood pressure, and cholesterol.
- Alcohol and drug use. Yes, a moderate amount of alcohol can limit your risk, but the key
 word is "moderate." And drugs like cocaine and amphetamines can trigger muscle spasms
 in your heart that could cause an attack.
- Stress. Stress and anger can elevate your blood pressure and tempt you toward overeating and drinking too much.

Surprising sources of pain

It's an old joke: "Doctor, it hurts when I lift my left arm over my head!" "Well then, don't do that!"

The causes of pain aren't always obvious. Consider these unexpected sources:

- Back pain. Taking your vitamins? Chronic back pain can be caused by low levels of vitamin D. Another possibility: constipation caused by block—age in the colon. Eat more fruits, vegetables, and fiber for better digestion. (Source: Prevention magazine)
- Achy feet. Wearing sandals or flip-flops can cause pain in your feet, ankles and knees due to poor arch support. (Source: the Web MD website)
- **Headache.** Cheese may be the culprit. A substance called tyramine in cheese can trigger headaches. Also, low blood sugar can create a headache even before you realize you're hungry. A snack like whole-grain crackers with peanut butter can bring quick relief. (Source: the Web MD website)

A cool idea: Keep food safe in your refrigerator



our workplace refrigerator (and your fridge at home, for that matter) should keep everyone's lunches and beverages safe. But we've all heard jokes about biologi-cal horrors growing inside a storage container on the bottom shelf in the back. Keep your food, your co-workers, and your family healthy with these refrigerator safety tips:

- **Monitor the temperature.** The interior of your refrigerator should stay at 40° F or below at all times, and your freezer should be set to 0° F. Install a thermometer to ensure foods are stored at safe temperatures.
- Check food regularly. At least every three months, go through your fridge top to bottom (and don't forget the door). Check expiration dates, and look for food that's obviously spoiled.
- Store food properly. Don't crowd items—allow cool air to circulate freely through the space. Be sure that raw meats, fish, and poultry are carefully wrapped so they don't contaminate any surfaces. Don't keep anything perishable in the door—the temperature fluctuates as the door is opened and closed throughout the day, which can contribute to rapid spoilage.
- Check the seal. If you're losing air, food will go bad more quickly (and you'll waste energy, too). Test the seal by closing the door on a sheet of paper. If you have to tug the paper to get it free, you're probably OK.
- If the power goes out . . . Monitor the temperature inside your fridge if the power goes out for longer than two hours. If it rises above 40° F for more than two hours, you'll need to discard perishable items. Your freezer should remain at 40° F or below for two full days in a power failure, if it's kept full. Arrange foods so meats don't drip their juices onto other foods if they thaw.

Tips for staying awake at the wheel

nap can be pleasant and relaxing—unless you're at the wheel of a car when it happens. The U.S. Department of Transportation estimates that sleep-related driving accidents Leause 40,000 injuries and 150 deaths every year. Don't be one of them. Follow these tips for staying awake and alert on the road:

- Get enough sleep. If you know you'll be driving a long distance, plan to get the sleep you need ahead of time. Take a nap before you leave if you'll be driving late—but avoid driving late at night if at all possible, as you'll be naturally sleepy anyway no matter how rested you feel.
- Get proper nutrition. Stay hydrated—drink lots of water. Coffee, tea, and energy drinks may provide a temporary boost, but remember that they can wear off quickly and leave you with less energy than before. The same goes for candy. Eat fruit, sunflower seeds, or high-carb granola bars, and don't gobble them down in a few bites. Eating slowly forces you to keep your attention level up.
- Don't get too comfortable. Open the window to keep cold air blowing on your face, or adjust your seat just enough to be noticeable as you drive (but not enough to distract you). Listen to loud music—maybe music you don't like—or talk radio, as long as it doesn't get you too
- Pull over. If all else fails, find a safe spot to pull over and take a nap. Fifteen or 20 minutes may be enough to get you through the rest of your trip safely.


