

# **Identity Theft**

### Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

### How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

### How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- · Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

# **Imposter Scam**

### The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in authority. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.

**Dunedin Cares Food Pantry** serves Dunedin, Clearwater and Palm Harbor. **Dunedin Cares Food Pantry**, **1630 Pinehurst Road**, **Dunedin**, opened its doors in 2015 and over time evolved from providing food bags to a "supermarket" approach, which enables clients to choose items they would prefer. Dunedin Cares Food Pantry days and hours are Mondays, 5:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m., Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, 9:30 a.m. – noon.

Registration: The only requirement is a valid photo ID showing an address in Dunedin, Clearwater, or Palm Harbor.

Countryside Cares Helping Hands Food Pantry serves all residents of Pinellas County. Helping Hands, 1850 McMullen Booth Road, Clearwater, is an outreach and food distribution service to those in need. This location provides drive through food distribution on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. The check-in begins at 8:30 a.m. and distribution starts at 11 a.m.

Registration: The only requirement is a valid photo ID with a Pinellas County address.

I wanted to take this opportunity to **THANK YOU** all for supporting the Park 3 Association this past year.




- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.

# The Mysterious Gift Under the Tree

# Ask the right questions

sking questions is the key to creative thinking, but you've got to ask the right kinds of questions. Here are some ideas for generating questions that get results:



- Write variations of the same question. Without overthinking it or second-guessing your-self, quickly write at least 10 variations of the question you're exploring. "How can we reduce expenses?" could become, "How can I persuade people to reduce expenses?" and "Where can we easily cut expenses?" and so forth. Each iteration will produce a new and different idea.
- Analyze everything. Don't go through life on autopilot. Take a hard look at little annoyances, for example, and try to find ways to eliminate them—"How can I stop getting interrupted for nonessential problems?" for example. Examine the tools that help you every day and look for ways to maximize them: "How can I get more out of all the applications on my computer?"
- Question your first solution. Maybe you've got an answer to your question, but don't stop there. Reinterpret it. For example, look for ways your solution could be improved, misused, or used to solve other problems. This helps you look past your assumptions and consider new perspectives.

# Marvin Gaye's serendipitous accidents

ne of singer/songwriter Marvin Gaye's most successful albums was What's Going On. Gaye worked hard on the album, but some of its most original moments came from mistakes. As an article of the LifeHacker website relates:

"Interestingly, two of the most singular aspects of What's Going On that were extended to the album began as errors. The opening alto-sax solo by Eli Fontaine actually was a warm-up phrase for an overdub that Gaye decided to keep. And Gaye's harmonized duets with himself occurred when Ken Sands, the engineer, accidentally played back two of his vocal versions on one mono tape."

Accidents can sometime produce surprising results.

# **Raising Strong Grandkids**

Telp your grandchildren to become more resilient by focusing on these three areas:

- 1. Negative thoughts. If you were ever the last one picked for a team in P.E. or someone whose accomplishments were compared against those of an older sibling or a prodigy neighbor kid, then you'll know firsthand the doubt, dread and lack of confidence that can overtake a young mind. Don't allow your children to fall victim to a spirit of defeat.
- 2. Encourage them to share their thoughts. Then help them improve their outlook by exploring strategies and solutions that will empower their thinking and inspire a willingness to strive for more.
- 3. Feelings. Sometimes as parents we're too quick to step in and say, "Don't worry. Everything will work out." Yet this approach doesn't allow your children to recognize and process how they are feeling, nor understand how their feelings can influence behavior.
- 5. Give youngsters a judgment-free forum for exploring their emotions, and offer insight and constructive feedback for dealing with those emotions.
- 6. Fears. Confronting adversity helps to develop problem-solving skills and gives us the confidence to make better choices.
- 7. Don't allow children to give up when times are tough. Encourage kids to face their fears with positive actions and perseverance. They may not always come out on top, but they will be able to hold their heads up knowing they did their best.
