






Warning signs of identity theft The top types of imposter scams:

Bills for items you did not buy

- · Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- · Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- · Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- · Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- · Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- · Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- · Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are someone in authority. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- · Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- · IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- · Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- · Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with vour account.


Family Scams

Christmas in Dunedin: A Coastal Town's Timeless Glow

Then December settles over Dunedin, it doesn't bring snowdrifts or icy winds. Instead, it brings the glow of lights strung across Main Street, the scent of salt and orange blossoms, and the hum of boats preparing for one of Florida's most beloved holiday traditions, the Dunedin Holiday Boat Parade.

For more than a century, Christmas in this small Gulf Coast city has reflected both its Scottish roots and its seaside charm. Founded in the late 1800s by Scotsmen J.O. Douglas and James Somerville, Dunedin took its name from the Gaelic *Dùn Èideann* — Edinburgh — and carried that heritage into nearly every part of community life.



"Dunedin has always had a strong sense of identity," said Heather Carmichael, curator at the Dunedin Historical Museum. "You see it in the tartans at the Highland Games, and you see it in the way we celebrate the holidays, it's about family, tradition, and connection."

Christmases Past

In the early 1900s, Dunedin was still a modest settlement surrounded by citrus groves and pine. Families gathered in small wooden churches, often lit by oil lamps and cooled by the winter breeze from the Gulf. Children would decorate their homes with handmade ornaments, strings of seashells, palm fronds, and citrus garlands.

For Christmas dinner, locals might have enjoyed baked fish from the harbor, fresh vegetables from the homestead, and pies made with Florida oranges instead of northern apples. "It was a simple life," Carmichael said. "But there was a real sense of community. You didn't need snow to feel the Christmas spirit."

The War Years and the Waterfront

During World War II, Dunedin's Christmases took on a quieter, more reflective tone. The city's waterfront was home to a U.S. Coast Guard training base, and families would hang lanterns along the docks on Christmas Eve, a sign of hope for those serving at sea.

Old photographs in the museum show sailors joining locals at holiday dances and helping decorate palm trees in Pioneer Park. "It was a time of unity," said Carmichael. "Even though it was wartime, people made sure the lights still shone."

From Main Street to the Marina

By the 1950s and 60s, as Dunedin grew into a bustling small town, Main Street became the heart of holiday celebrations. Shop owners draped lights across their storefronts, children rode bicycles in parades, and Santa sometimes arrived not by sleigh, but by fishing boat.

That maritime touch eventually inspired the Holiday Boat Parade, a now-iconic event that began in the 1970s. What started with a few fishermen decorating their vessels has grown into a spectacle that draws thousands of residents and visitors each December.

As the illuminated boats glide through the harbor, reflections shimmer across St. Joseph Sound, and families line the seawall, sipping cocoa and waving to friends aboard. The parade ends near Edgewater Park, where the city's Christmas tree lighting marks the official start of the season.

"It's one of those events that really captures who we are," said longtime resident John McRae, whose family has lived in Dunedin for four generations. "We're a waterfront town with deep roots, and we like to celebrate in our own way."




