

### **Identity Theft** Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- · Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- · Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

### How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

### How to protect yourself from identity theft

- · Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- · Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- · Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- · Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

### **Imposter Scam**

### The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are someone in authority. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- · Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- · IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- · Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- · Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with vour account.



### **Social Security**

# Social Security beneficiaries will get a 2.8 percent increase in their monthly payments next year, the Social Security Administration (SSA) announced on Oct. 24.

The 2026 cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) is slightly higher than last year's 2.5 percent increase, reflecting a recent uptick in inflation.

The 2.8 percent COLA will boost the average monthly benefit for a retired worker by about \$56, from \$2,015 to \$2,071, according to SSA estimates. The average monthly survivor benefit would inch up by about \$52, and the average payment for a worker collecting Social Security Disability Insurance would go up by \$44.

The COLA announcement, initially scheduled for Oct. 15, was delayed by nine days due to the federal government shutdown. However, the bump in benefits will take effect on time, starting with December Social Security payments, which are issued in January.

The annual COLA "plays a crucial role in supporting older Americans, helping ensure retirement income keeps pace with inflation," Dr. Meechai Minter-Jordan, AARP's chief executive officer, said in a statement.

### **COLA follows inflation — with a lag**

Rob Williams, managing director of financial planning at Charles Schwab, says Social Security recipients will welcome the boost, even though many may feel it should be higher.

"Inflation has been a top concern, both emotionally and financially, for a lot of Americans, retirees included," Williams says. "It feels like everything is getting more expensive."

Lucy Haverfield, a 72-year-old retiree living in Florida, says she lives on a "razor-thin" margin with her \$2,500 monthly Social Security payment, her only income. "Milk, eggs, bread, gas, name something — everything is up," she says.

"I appreciate that they are doing something," Haverfield says of the COLA increase. "Is it what we really need? [For] those of us on a fixed income, I'd say no."

Annual COLAs are based on year-over-year changes in the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) during the third quarter of the year.

The CPI-W measures price trends for a market basket of goods and services, such as food, clothing, housing and transportation. It's a subset of the overall Consumer Price Index, the federal government's main gauge of inflation.






### **Clearwater Police Department**



- Residents are advised to remain vigilant at ATMs and never hand over their bank cards to anyone they do not know.
- The police have reported multiple victims affected by this scam, and similar incidents may occur elsewhere in the area.

Scammers are good at **pretending to be someone that they're not**. They try to trick you into thinking **a loved one is in trouble.** 

Once the scammer makes you think they're your grandson and in trouble, they pressure you to quickly send them money. **But it's all a scam.**Your family member was never in trouble.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's important to keep it secret. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will **play with your emotions.** They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.

### The Mysterious Gift Under the Tree

ne Christmas Eve, a family gathered around the tree, finishing up the last of the cocoa and carols. As the children were sent off to bed, the parents noticed a small, unmarked gift tucked deep behind the tree. Neither of them had placed it there. Curious, they opened it to find a handmade ornament with the words: "Believe in the magic." Inside was a note from their late grandmother, written years before she passed, thanking them for keeping the family traditions alive. She had hidden the gift during her last Christmas with them, hoping it would be found when they needed it most. That year, the family had been struggling with grief, and the unexpected message brought comfort and tears—reminding them that love endures, even after loss.

### The Christmas Truce of 1914

uring World War I, on Christmas Eve 1914, something extraordinary happened. British and German soldiers, entrenched in bitter combat, spontaneously ceased fire. Soldiers from both sides emerged from their trenches, met in no man's land, and exchanged greetings, food, and even played a game of football. They sang carols together and buried their dead with dignity. Though brief, the truce was a powerful reminder of shared humanity—even in the darkest of times. It remains one of the most poignant examples of peace breaking through conflict, if only for a day.

### The Turkey That Got Away

ne Christmas, a family decided to go all out and buy a fresh turkey from a local farm instead of the usual frozen one. The dad was in charge of picking it up, and he proudly brought home a massive bird. But when it came time to cook it, the oven door wouldn't close—it was too big.

So, they tried trimming it. Still too big. Then they tried rotating it. Still no luck. Eventually, they gave up and decided to cook it on the grill outside. But halfway through, it started raining—hard. The dad, determined not to let Christmas dinner be ruined, stood outside with an umbrella, flipping the turkey like a warrior defending his feast.

Hours later, they finally brought it in, only to discover... it was still raw in the middle. They ended up eating side dishes and pie for dinner, and the turkey became the next day's project. The family now jokes that the turkey was so big it needed its own zip code—and they've gone back to frozen ever since.





### Writer's block? Vanquish it with these tips

Triters of all kinds sometimes fall prey to blocks. Whether you're writing a novel, a poem, or a business article, these tips can help you get past those blocks and get back on track:

- Start early. You have more willpower and energy in the morning, so use it to your advantage. You'll also have fewer interruptions and distractions while other people are just pouring their first cup of coffee, and you'll be able to put off less-important tasks for when you have the time to devote to them.
- Select a goal. Challenge yourself to write 5,000 words, work for two hours straight, finish a chapter, or write half your article before you move on. This gives you something concrete to strive for.
- Warm up. Spend a few minutes describing something around you, recreating a conversation from yesterday, writing down a dream, or just recording random thought as they come into your head. The practice of writing something—anything—will help get your mind in gear.
- Leave it unfinished. Some writers make a habit of stopping in the middle of a sentence so they have a natural starting point the next morning. If that doesn't work for you, try leaving what you're working on incomplete once you've reached your daily goal. You'll find it easier to continue when you have a natural jumping-off point.
- **Don't push yourself.** Sometimes the only thing to do is step away from the keyboard for a while. Let your mind wander without getting lost in another subject. After a few minutes (or hours) you'll be able to return with a fresh perspective.


