




Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- · Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The **fraud department at your credit card issuers**, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- · Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in **authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.

PRESIDENT'S CORNER

It is that time of year when our annual elections, which are managed by Resource Property Management, take up a great deal of time and focus by our office staff. Not only are they managing their daily tasks, but they are also kicking into high gear at the window welcoming our snowbirds back to the park, all the while working to meet several annual meeting communication deadlines. I can't stress enough how a few moments of your time to choose to ease the demands will make a difference. We want your vote to count, and we want our communications to reach you in a timely manner. Here are some ways you can help:

- 1. Please ensure your **voting certificate** is up to date by checking in with the office. This is the designated voter form that would have been completed to determine who in your household is the designated shareholder to cast a vote. There may only be one vote per share. This is required only if there are multiple shareholders on your share. The form is not required if husband and wife are the only names on the share. The form is only valid if signatures of all shareholders of your unit are included. If you've added names to your share (example: for estate purposes); a voting certificate is required.
- 2. Please consider signing up to **vote electronically** if you haven't already done so in a previous election. An email will be sent where you may choose this option. We have had trouble with the mailing of paper in the past. It has become inefficient and unreliable, in my opinion, but we are required to do so unless you choose otherwise. Please help us by choosing this option if you are comfortable with using your computer, tablet or cell phone to access the web-based link to answer proxy questions and to vote privately for the candidates of your choice. Please ensure the email address to reach you is valid if you signed up previously.
- 3. And lastly, as a shareholder, you have the option to receive official park-business notices via email, rather than by surface mail. Such notices include the Year-End Financial Statements, proposed changes to the Rules and Regulations of the park and the proposed annual budget. Choosing to receive association business emails electronically is separate from being on the Sunset Palms 3401email distribution list for daily communications such the pool is closed. Do not assume because you receive those emails that you are signed up to receive park-business emails electronically. This is entirely separate from the electronic voting form.

We encourage you to sign up for this option as it has several benefits: the documentation is received on a timelier basis, the documentation may be viewed anywhere and at any time, and it saves the association, thus you, money.



Water to individual Homes

fter receiving numerous calls from the Resource Property Management After Hours Call Center with residents wanting to know when the water in the Park is going to be turned back on when the water has not been shut off, maintenance and I felt that it might be a good idea to explain how the water to individual homes in the Park works.

How do I turn off the water to my home when I leave for an extended period of time?

Every home has a main water shut off valve that is located where the water line enters the home. This valve may be located under their home, near the hot water heater, or in some cases in the shed of the home. It is the homeowner's responsibility to know where this water valve is located and to be able to turn their water on and off.

What if I can't locate the water shut off valve to my home?

The homeowner will need to contact a plumber to locate the main water shut off valve and show them how to turn the water to their home on and off. If the plumber is unable to locate a main shut-off valve to your home, one will need to be installed.

Do I need to turn the water off at the Water Riser behind my home?

No. While it is the homeowner's responsibility to know what shut off valves on the Water Riser

are for their home, utilizing the home's main water shut off valve is sufficient to turn the water off when you are leaving the park for an extended period of time and to turn the water back on when you return to the park.

What is the difference between turning off the Water Riser shut-off valve or my home's water shut-off valve?

The Water Riser shut off valve is the connection point from the Park's main water line to your home. Turning off the riser valve cuts off water to your entire home at the point where it enters the property from the Park's system.

The mobile home's main shut-off valve is typically located outside the home where the water line enters the home or in newer homes near the water heater. Using the home's main valve to shut off water turns the water off at a point closer to the structure.

What are the different color pipes on the Water Riser?

The yellow pipe is for well water, and the blue pipe is for fresh water.

What do I do if I have a plumber working on the pipes in my home?

A licensed plumber will determine what shut off valves will need to be turned off to work on your home.

It is important for the homeowner to know which Water Riser shut-off valves are for their home to ensure that the plumber is turning off their water supply at the Water Riser and not their neighbors.'

Many of the after-hour calls that we receive are because a plumber was working at a home and turned off all the shut-off valves on the Water Riser and did not turn all the valves back on when he left, leaving the homeowner's neighbor without water.

Being aware of how to shut off and turn on water to your home is a necessity. If you are selling or subletting your home, please be sure to tell the new owners or the people that are subletting how to turn the home's main water valve on and off. Doing this can alleviate stress for the homeowner, the subletter, and early morning and late-night calls to the staff.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation regarding this important matter.

The Mysterious Gift Under the Tree

ne Christmas Eve, a family gathered around the tree, finishing up the last of the cocoa and carols. The Christmas Truce of 1914

Family Scams

Scammers are good at pretending to be someone that they're not. They try to trick you into thinking a loved one is in trouble.

Once the scammer makes you think they're your grandson and in trouble, they pressure you to quickly send them money. But it's all a scam. Your family member was never in trouble.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's important to keep it **secret**. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will play with your emotions. They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.

Slow down. Verify.

Example of a Family Emergency Scam Call Hi Grandpa, it's me Sebastian? Is that you? Yes, it's me, Sebastian. Grandpa, I'm in trouble. and I need money for bail. What happened? Please don't tell Mom or Dad. I'll get in so much trouble. Please help me!
