




Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- · Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- · Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- · Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- · Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- · Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are someone in authority. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- · IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- · Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- · Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- · Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with vour account.

MUSCOVEY DUCKS

Residents are reminded that feeding, protecting or otherwise 'nurturing' the large black and white (Muscovey) ducks seen throughout the community is 'illegal' and according to PETA (People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals) is harmful and detrimental to health of the ducks themselves.



A recent count puts the number of Muscoveys within Gateway at two dozen. This cannot be allowed to continue for in short order two dozen will become four. Feeding the large black and white Muscovey ducks that wander about the park is a violation of park rules and federal and state law.

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission considers them a nuisance animal:

Muscovy ducks have been introduced into urban and suburban areas in Florida where they often occur in high densities. These birds were illegally released primarily by private individuals for ornamental purposes or as pets. Muscovy ducks can be extremely prolific and local populations can increase dramatically in a short time. As a result, controversies frequently arise between residents who enjoy the birds and residents who consider them a nuisance.

Because this introduced, non-native species sometimes creates problems through competition with native species, damage to property, and transmission of disease, in 2010 the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service revised its regulations concerning Muscovy ducks.

In addition, nesting ducks attract predator and scavenging animals, raccoons, opossums, feral cats, skunks and coyotes to the area. If you observe or suspect any animal has chosen to use the area around or under your home as their own, contact the Gateway Office and request the unwelcome guest be trapped and removed.

NOTE: Residents walking dogs on 1st Way in the area of the maintenance shed have come under attack from the male black swan. As Greg Ely has reported he believes eggs of the nesting pair may soon hatch and I have to believe both black swans likely to become even more aggressive protecting cygnets.



Spinach Salad with Apricot Dressing

The salad base:

- • 10 oz pkg baby spinach
- • 1 pint grape tomatoes, halved
- • 1 small red onion, thinly sliced
- • 1/2 cup chopped dried apricots
- 4 oz Feta cheese crumbles
- • 1 ripe avocado, peeled and diced
- • 1/2 cup chopped pecans, toasted

Whisk for the dressing:

- • 1/3 cup neutral oil (canola, avocado, etc)
- • 2 Tbsp white wine vinegar
- 2 Tbsp orange juice
- • 2 Tbsp apricot jam or apple jelly
- • 1/2 tsp. salt
- • 1/2 tsp ground coriander
- • 1/2 tsp ground pepper

Pour dressing over greens mixture and toss to coat. This is a great accompaniment to chicken or pork dishes.

Homemade Blueberry Muffins

A favorite any time of year!



The science behind perfect blueberry muffins involves a few techniques – read these before you start making the muffins.

- Start with a high baking temperature (425°F) for 5 minutes this creates that signature domed top, while reducing to 350°F ensures the interior bakes through without burning.
- Buttermilk is awesome in this recipe but, if you don't have buttermilk, no problem. It's easy to make your own and it won't take more than a few minutes. Simply add 1 tablespoon of white vinegar (or lemon juice) to 1 cup of whole milk. Stir well and let it stand for 5 minutes. Voila!
- Make sure your baking soda and powder are fresh. If you don't bake frequently, just replace them about every 6 months.
- Don't overmix the batter. Use a spoon or spatula, never a mixer for making muffins. Use a folding motion to keep the batter light. Mix just until the flour disappears. In fact, it's okay if there's a tiny bit of flour that's not mixed in.
- Coating blueberries in flour prevents them from sinking to the bottom, resulting in perfectly distributed berries throughout each muffin.
- Fill the muffins fairly full, ½ inch from the top.
- Let the muffin batter sit for about 15 minutes in the muffin cups before baking. This gives the gluten time to relax.

Finally, the recipe!

- • ½ cup butter melted and
- cooled for 5 minutes
- 1 cup sugar
- 2 large eggs
- • ³/₄ cup of whole buttermilk –
- low fat will also work
- • 2 teaspoons of vanilla extract

- • 2 ½ cups of all-purpose flour
- • 1 tablespoon of baking powder
- 1 teaspoon of baking soda
- ½ teaspoon of kosher salt
- 1 ½ cups of fresh blueberries
- • Turbinado (raw) or Demerara sugar
- Preheat the oven to 425 degrees F. Spray muffin pan generously with non-stick spray.
- In a medium bowl whisk the melted-cooled butter with the sugar then add the eggs and stir well to combine. Add butter milk and vanilla, Stir again until combined.
- Sprinkle the flour with the baking powder, baking soda and salt evenly over the top and stir just until flour mixture is incorporated. Gently, fold in the blueberries using a rubber spatula.
- Scoop the batter into the 12 muffin cups and sprinkle each one with a scant teaspoon of Demerara or Turbinado sugar. Wait 15 minutes before baking muffins.
- Bake for 5 minutes at 425°F, then reduce the heat to 350°F and bake for another 12-16 minutes or until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean. Muffins will also spring back when lightly touched on the top when done.



Scammers are good at **pretending to be someone that they're not.** They try to trick you into thinking **a loved one is in trouble.**

Once the scammer makes you think they're your grandson and in trouble, they pressure you to quickly send them money. **But it's all a scam.**Your family member was never in trouble.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's important to keep it secret. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will **play with your emotions.** They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.


