Paradise Island will continue as a Not-for-Profit Co-Op, offering all our resident's low rates with a great social structure and a well-maintained community.

The front entrance island has been enhanced to better welcome our residents' home and to better welcome all visitors and any potential new residents to our great community. We hope you like the changes that have been made, and we are always listening to your suggestions to enhance the community and your enjoyment here.

As a reminder, open fires of any kind outside are prohibited by our rules and fire safety laws here in Largo. Our homes here are sensitive, and fire can cause a big problem for your home and the homes around you. No fire pits or anything other than a nice BBQ grill cookout are

allowed. If you see a fire, please call 911.

Other construction projects that have now been completed: the roadwork repairs, fence repairs leftover from the hurricanes last year, and the repair of the pond banks on ponds 3 and 5. Did You Know?

You need to notify the Park Office of your change of address when you leave for the season and then upon your return. This provides the direct delivery of important mail from Paradise Island Co-Op, eliminating the delays caused by mail forwarding or missing critical mailings that are delivered to your address here instead of where you are located. Contact information forms for address/phone number changes are available at the office, on the Paradise Island Website, and online at the Resource Property Management Portal.

Your PI account information is available online for your review and to make online payments as needed. Below are the steps for viewing your account balance and/or for making payments.

- 1. Log in to resourcepropertymgmt.com
- 2. Click on *Vantaca Home or Owner Login* and enter your email address. If you encounter any difficulties, instructions are on the screen to help you. For problems with sign-in, please call RPM at 727-581-2662.
- 3. Once logged in, your account information and balance information are available, along with account details and the option to make a Credit Card /eCheck payment.
- 4. Other information and resident forms are available by clicking the three (3) lines next to your name at the top left and selecting *Documents*.
- 5. There is an additional step for shareholders to access Co-Op Documents. To the right top, where your account address is listed, click the drop-down and select <u>PIC Docs</u> (<u>shareholders</u>). Then select <u>Documents</u>, as noted in 4. Above.





Romance Scams



The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can
 use details shared on social media and dating sites to better
 understand and target you.
- Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone.




Family Scams

Once the scammer makes you think they're your grandson and in trouble, they pressure you to quickly send them money. **But it's all a scam.**Your family member was never in trouble.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's important to keep it secret. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will **play with your emotions.** They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.

Expands Groundbreaking Research into Psychedelic Therapy

The Department of Veterans Affairs has confirmed it is expanding psychedelic-assisted therapy trials for veterans diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), treatment resistant depression, and anxiety disorders.

Nine VA facilities, in the Bronx, Los Angeles, Omaha, Palo Alto, Portland (Oregon), San Diego, San Francisco, West Haven, and White River Junction; are participating in the multi-year studies, each designed to test the safety and clinical impact of psychedelic compounds used

VA Press Secretary Pete Kasperowicz told Military.com the work is proceeding under "strict safety and regulatory procedure," noting that all studies involve substances still listed under Schedule I of the Controlled Substances Act (CSA).

"VA's work on psychedelics is at an early stage and results from these trials will be available in the years to come," Kasperowicz said. "This research is just one part of VA's comprehensive mental health and suicide prevention efforts."

For many veterans, existing PTSD treatments, such as cognitive processing therapy or medication can help manage symptoms but don't always resolve the underlying trauma.

That challenge has pushed VA researchers to explore new models of care. In 2024, the VA announced funding for MDMA- and psilocybin-assisted therapy studies, marking the first time the agency directly supported psychedelic research for veteran mental health. The new expansion builds on that foundation. Each site will recruit participants based on specific diagnostic criteria and treatment history. Some trials focus on combat-related PTSD, while others include veterans with depression or generalized anxiety disorder who have not responded to standard therapies.

"The goal is not to replace traditional care," one VA research summary explains, "but to determine whether psychedelic-assisted therapy can enhance recovery for patients who haven't improved with existing options."

How Psychedelics May Work in Therapy - The compounds under study, primarily MDMA and psilocybin, are being used alongside structured psychotherapy sessions led by trained clinicians. Veterans receive preparatory counseling before dosing sessions, followed by integration therapy to help process their experiences.

Dr. Rachel Yehuda, director of PTSD Research at the Bronx VA and a key figure in trauma studies at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, has emphasized that the therapy's effectiveness depends on its structure, not just the compound. Because the substances remain federally controlled, each study is conducted under a Schedule I research license, approved and monitored by both the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

All facilities must meet stringent storage, handling, and documentation standards. Therapists receive specialized training, and each dosing session includes medical monitoring and


psychological support. The VA says its research teams remain in close contact with FDA and DEA officials throughout the process to ensure compliance and participant safety. This level of oversight reflects the balance between innovation and regulation. Psychedelics are still federally restricted, but the FDA has granted "Breakthrough Therapy" status to several compounds under investigation, recognizing their potential to address unmet medical needs.

The VA's move mirrors growing bipartisan interest in psychedelic medicine. In recent years, members of Congress from both parties have supported increased funding for veteran-focused mental health research, including novel therapies that show promise in early trials. Still, VA officials emphasize that this is not an endorsement of psychedelics as approved treatments. Every study remains experimental, and it will take years before researchers can determine whether these therapies are safe, effective, and scalable for widespread use within the VA system. VA officials emphasized that the research remains in early stages and is being conducted cautiously, guided by scientific oversight and the agency's mission to improve veteran health.




