Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- · Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The **fraud department at your credit card issuers**, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- · Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam


The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in **authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.



Veteran's Corner

Dakto South Vietnam, December 24, 1968

Te received information from our intelligence unit, that the North Vietnamese Army was preparing to attack and destroy a Catholic Orphanage in Pleiku province on Christmas Day, December 25th.

Our Company scrambled to a Landing Zone under darkness and were flown to Pleiku, outside that orphanage, with South Vietnamese Army regulars. Upon reaching the gates of the orphanage, the South Vietnamese Regulars, spoke with the Priest and Nuns informing them what was about to happen on Christmas Day.

Our company entered the orphanage which only baby girls were being cared for. We extracted the babies, and brought them out to our nurses. I carried a baby girl probably only two to three months young. We successfully liberated that orphanage before the NVA was preparing to destroy it, and all the occupants inside.

Upon returning home from Vietnam, I was assigned to Fort Knox, KY. Demonstrators were protesting the War and burning American Flags. Outside the post in my fatigues, before returning home, I was filling our car with gas, when a teenage boy approached me, pointing his fingers at me calling me "one of those Baby Killers".

Without incident, I left and drove home. My new bride Jane noticed I was upset. I told her what just happened. We both hugged each other teary eyed. If that young boy only knew what we did in that orphanage several months earlier, he may have not called me that.

We were Peacekeepers, not Baby Killers. If the baby I carried out survived all these years later. She would probably be over 50 years of age. I regret I never knew her age.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's important to keep it secret. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will **play with your emotions.** They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.

Slow down. Verify.

December Birthstones

ecember has three primary birthstones: Turquoise, Tanzanite, and Zircon. These stones are known for their various shades of blue, with turquoise featuring sky-blue hues, tanzanite offering a blend of blue and violet, and zircon often seen in brilliant blue colors. While blue topaz is also a popular choice for December, especially in a deep "London Blue" variation, it is not considered an official birthstone for the month.

Turquoise

December Fun Facts & Recipes

hristmas traditions often have pre-Christian and pagan roots, with the celebration on December 25th being established in the 4th century to coincide with existing winter solstice festivals like Saturnalia. The word "Christmas" itself originates from the Middle English phrase "Christ's Mass". Key figures and traditions, such as Santa Claus's image and the popularizing of Christmas trees, were influenced by marketing and historical events, while the date of Jesus's birth is not mentioned in the Bible.

Recipe

The oldest recorded recipe associated with Christmas is for a spiced meat and fruit pie, a precursor to the modern mince pie, found in the English cookbook The Forme of Cury, dating back to 1390.

Written by the master cooks of King Richard II, the book contains a recipe called "tartes of flessh" ("tarts of flesh"). This medieval dish was a mixture of savory and sweet flavors, made with meat, dried fruits, spices, and a pastry crust. The ingredients, such as saffron and spices, were status symbols of the wealthy and were often associated with important feasts.

The original Christmas spiced meat and fruit pie evolved from medieval recipes and became the traditional mince pie. In the Middle Ages, meat, fruits, and spices were combined as a method of food preservation and later developed religious significance for Christmas.

The Mysterious Gift Under the Tree

ne Christmas Eve, a family gathered around the tree, finishing up the last of the cocoa and carols. As the children were sent off to bed, the parents noticed a small, unmarked gift tucked deep behind the tree. Neither of them had placed it there. Curious, they opened it to find a handmade ornament with the words: "Believe in the magic." The Christmas Truce of 1914

They sang carols together and buried their dead with dignity. Though brief, the truce was a powerful reminder of shared humanity—even in the darkest of times. It remains one of the most poignant examples of peace breaking through conflict, if only for a day.

ne Christmas, a family decided to go all out and buy a fresh turkey from a local farm instead of the usual frozen one. The dad was in charge of picking it up, and he proudly brought home a massive bird. But when it came time to cook it, the oven door wouldn't close—it was too big.





